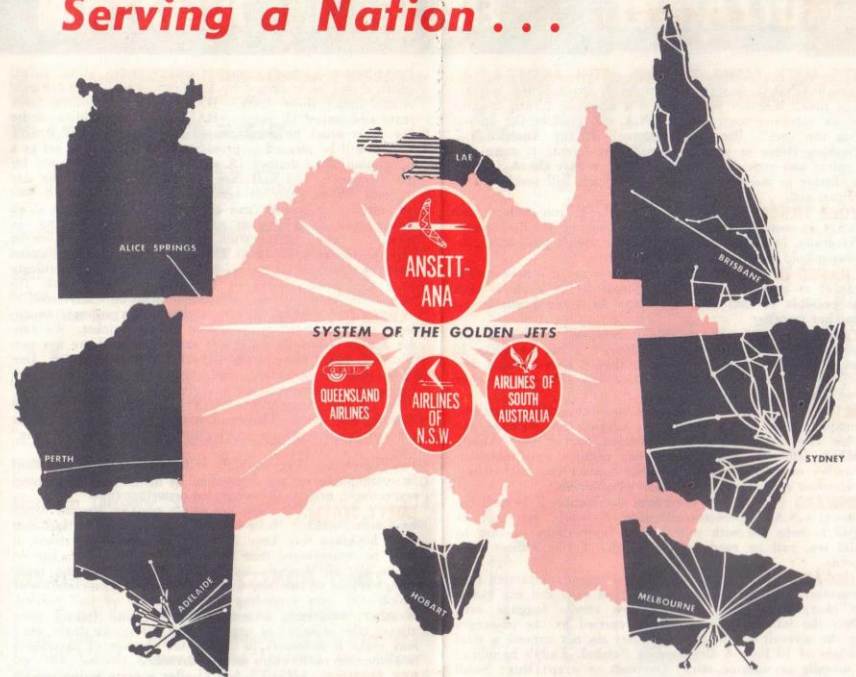

SERVICE INFORMATION

IT'S MUCH EASIER TO BOOK WITH ANSETT-A.N.A.: Ansett-A.N.A.'s reservation system is streamlined to save you time. Whether your need is a single or return booking or an extensive tour, Ansett-A.N.A. can produce the answer "on the spot". Ring, write or call at any Ansett-A.N.A. Booking Office or your nearest Travel Agent. If more convenient and your reservation is for some days ahead, forward a cheque or money order and your ticket will reach you by return mail.

YOUR TICKET: It will assist greatly if you collect your ticket as soon as possible after the booking has been made. Naturally, in the interests of other intending passengers, we cannot hold unticketed seats indefinitely.

CHANGE OF PLANS? If circumstances make it necessary to cancel or postpone your flight, please let us know as soon as possible so that your seat may be made available for another traveller.

CANCELLATIONS: If you find it necessary to cancel your booking, the full fare will be refunded if not less than 12 hours' notice is given; if not less than 6 hours' notice, less 5%; if not less than 2 hours' notice, less 10%; if less than two hours' notice, 25%.

RETURN TRAVEL: To obviate possible disappointment, complete your return booking in advance. As soon as possible after arrival at your destination, contact your Ansett-A.N.A. Office or Travel Agent and register your telephone number or address so that we may contact you immediately regarding any unforeseen change of schedule.

ONWARD TRAVEL: If your final destination is beyond the Ansett-A.N.A. Commonwealth-wide Network, we will be glad to help you with your further reservations whether by air, sea, rail or road—just tell the Traffic Officer your needs.

LUGGAGE: Up to 35 lbs. of checked luggage is carried free, however, you may take as much as you wish and any excess is charged at Ansett-A.N.A.'s low excess luggage rate. Only the following items may be carried by the passenger in the aircraft cabin, provided they do not exceed a total weight of 10 lbs.: A Briefcase or Satchel; Lady's handbag; Umbrella or walking stick; Overcoat or wrap; Rug; Small camera or cinecamera and binoculars; Reading material for the flight.

Where members of the same family are travelling together to the same destination the free luggage allowance for each member may be grouped. If one member's luggage weighs 25 lbs. there is 10 lbs. extra weight which may be shared free by the remaining members of the family. D.C.A. regulations forbid the carriage of liquor, lighter fluid or goods of an inflammable, explosive or odious nature.

OVERSEAS LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE: Passengers from Overseas, travelling on IATA documentation, are permitted a free luggage allowance of 66 lbs. on First Class services (44 lbs. on Tourist services) during validity of IATA documents following their arrival at an Australian "Gateway" Port. Conversely, passengers travelling to connect with an Overseas departure, air or sea, are permitted a free luggage allowance of 66 lbs. on First Class services (44 lbs. on Tourist services) provided service travelled on is within 7 days of Overseas departure.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE: Your Flight Ticket is issued subject to the conditions printed on the back thereof.

TIPPING: Our staff do not expect, nor are they permitted to accept gratuities. Your Ticket entitles you to all available facilities.

MEALS: Meals and/or light refreshments are served at appropriate times to First Class passengers.

INSURANCE: Personal, Accident and Luggage insurance is available if required at small cost. Full details can be obtained on application.

CHILDREN'S AND STUDENTS' PRIVILEGES: One infant under three years nursed by an adult—FREE. Additional infants under three years—HALF FARE. Children three years and under 15 years—HALF FARE. Children under five years must be accompanied by an adult, but Ansett-A.N.A. will be pleased to provide an Air Hostess to act as a companion if so desired. A single fare only is charged for the companion and half fare for the child. Full time day students fifteen years of age and under nineteen and who are enrolled in a full time course for a school year at an Educational Establishment or University and are not in receipt of any remuneration are allowed a concession of half the ruling adult fare. The concession must be claimed when the booking is made, and supported by a certificate from the Head Master or Principal of the School. No claims for retrospective adjustment will be entertained.

"CHECK-IN" TIMES: You are urged most strongly to observe the "check-in" times shown on your ticket. We cannot accept responsibility if you arrive late and are not permitted to board the aircraft, even if it has not taken off. Due to the various operations and procedures necessary in ensuring the departure of an aircraft, it is not possible to embark further passengers after a given "deadline" without delaying the flight. The right is reserved to dispose of the seats of passengers who arrive after the scheduled "check-in" time.

Passengers travelling privately to the Airport or Flying Boat Base should arrive not later than 15 minutes or 30 minutes respectively, prior to the scheduled departure time.

EMPTY SEATS: You may see empty seats on aircraft which have been reported "fully booked". Apart from the fact that some bookings may have been last minute cancellations, it must be remembered that the number of passengers carried by an aircraft depends not only on the total seating available, but also on the total authorised load (luggage included) which may vary according to the amount of fuel carried. Weather conditions, an excess load of mail (which must always take priority) or urgent cargo (lifesaving drugs, etc.) may make it necessary to reduce the number of passengers in proportion to the extra weight carried.

PET SERVICE: ANSETT-A.N.A. offer a crate hiring service to enable you to transport your pet cat or dog, etc., comfortably and safely to your destination. Pets to cocker size may travel in the same aircraft, or you may send pets of any size independently at very small cost. Each pet is issued with its own attractive colored certificate from the "Kennel Club of the Air", see page 22 for further details. Enquiries or reservations at any ANSETT-A.N.A. Booking Office or Freight Depot.

AN AVIS DRIVE-YOURSELF OR A HIRE CAR? An Avis Drive-Yourself Car can be reserved for you to drive as your own for as long as you wish. Bookings can be arranged in advance or on arrival. Alternatively, should you require a Hire Car at destination your hostess will ascertain your requirements in flight.

PLANT AND FRUIT QUARANTINE: To prevent the spread of plant diseases, fruit fly and insect pests, you are requested by the Commonwealth Quarantine Authorities to refrain from carrying fruit, vegetables, seedlings and plant material from one part of Australia to another without a permit from the Department of Agriculture. . . Permits are obtainable from local Departments of Agriculture.

STOP-OVER PRIVILEGES: Stop-overs are permitted at intermediate ports on a through fare subject to arrangement at time and place of ticketing.

HOW TO READ YOUR TIMETABLE

TO LOCATE YOUR FLIGHT.

Listed on the right hand side of this page are the Ports served by ANSETT-ANA, together with their timetable number. To find a flight, locate your Departure Port and Destination Port in this index and refer to the respective table number or numbers. On each timetable you will find departure and arrival times, aircraft type, flight number, the frequency of operation and type of flight.

To assist you to distinguish between a.m. and p.m. times, a.m. times are shown in light face (9.35) and the p.m. times in heavy face (9.35). All times shown are local. Eastern Standard Times (E.S.T.) apply in Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and Tasmania. Central Standard Time (C.S.T.) is 30 minutes behind E.S.T. and is used in South Australia and Northern Territory. Western Standard Time (W.S.T.) is 2 hours behind E.S.T. and is used in Western Australia.

COACH FARES AND COACH TIMES.

Coach fares and times are also shown on this page. The time, shown in minutes, is the time taken by the Coach between City Terminal and Airport. For example, the coach time for Melbourne is 45 minutes, thus passengers wishing to connect with a departure from Melbourne airport at, say, 8.00 a.m. should note connecting coach will depart Melbourne City Terminal at 7.15 a.m.
