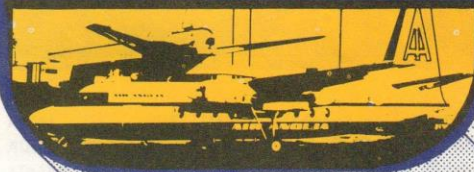

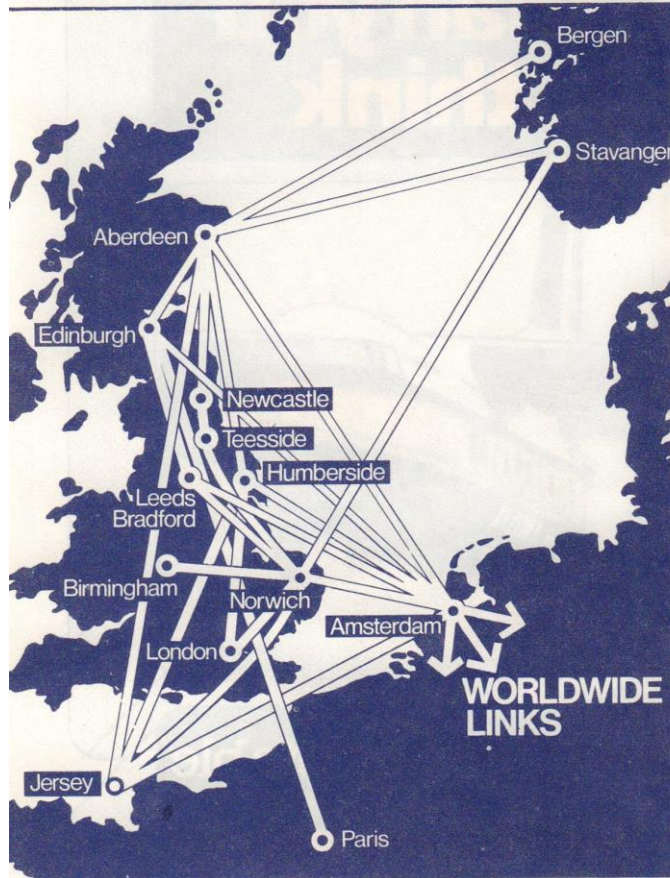

GENERAL INFORMATION

DEPARTURE/CHECK-IN-TIMES. Passengers must arrive at the airport early enough for all formalities to be completed. The formalities must be completed on **Domestic Flights 20 minutes before departure** and **International Flights 30 minutes before departure.**

RESERVATIONS. Seats to be reserved as far in advance as possible through Air Anglia or any travel agent. Passengers are warned that reservations will be only held until the check in close out time. After this time they will be automatically cancelled including any return or onward flights.

DENIED BOARDING COMPENSATION PLAN. Compensation will be paid if the flight for which you have a confirmed reservation is unable to accommodate you and departs without you. Full details of this plan are available at all Air Anglia offices.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE AND REGULATIONS. The carriage of passengers, baggage and cargo is subject to Air Anglia Ltd General Conditions of Carriage and Regulations, which may be seen on request at any Air Anglia office. The notes below are for general guidance and reference should be made to the appropriate Conditions or Regulations for full details.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS. AIR ANGLIA or its Agents will gladly provide, on request, information regarding Passports or any visa required for your journey, but you must ensure personally that these documents are in order because the carrier cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of any irregularity. You will have to show your passport during the journey, so please carry it with you.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES. Certain countries require valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination. Please enquire well in advance whether any such certificates are required for your journey.

CURRENCY CONTROL. The movement of money into and out of many countries is subject to Government control and you should consult your Travel Agent or any Bank about regulations applicable to your journey well before the date of travel.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Domestic. On domestic services one piece of baggage where the sum of the three dimensions does not exceed 67 inches, plus a reasonable amount of cabin baggage (this includes an underseat case not larger than 18" x 14" x 6"). Excess baggage will be carried, subject to space being available, at the published rates.

International Services. On international services the free allowance is 20 kgs. (44 lbs). There is no free allowance for an infant carried at 10% of the adult fare but infant's food for consumption during the flight and infant's carry-cot may be carried free of charge. Baggage in excess of the free allowance may be carried, subject to space being available, at the published rates.

Baggage should contain personal effects only, but you may carry commercial samples provided that you arrange to be at airport for international flights not later than the time specified by the local Customs; in the United Kingdom this is 40 minutes before the aircraft departure time.

PERSONAL ITEMS. In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge: a lady's handbag, an overcoat or wraps, a footrug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars, a fully collapsible invalid wheel chair and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight. Briefcases, typewriters and large cameras have to be included in the baggage allowance.

UNACCOMPANIED BAGGAGE. Unaccompanied baggage may be sent at normal cargo rates. In addition customs clearance, handling and/or cartage charges are payable.

ANIMALS. We regret we cannot carry animals in the passenger cabins. Livestock can be carried on most routes by prior arrangement.

GOLFING EQUIPMENT (International Services). In addition to the normal free baggage allowance, equipment up to 15kg., contained in not more than one golf bag and including one pair of golfing shoes, may be carried at a special rate equivalent to 4 kg., of excess baggage.

PROHIBITED ARTICLES. Articles such as the following shall not be carried in passengers' baggage without consent of and prior arrangement with AIR ANGLIA. Compressed gases (flammable, non-flammable and poisonous). Corrosives (such as acids, wet batteries). Explosives. Munitions, Fireworks and articles which are easily ignited. Flammable Liquids and Solids (such as lighter or heater fuels, matches). Oxidising materials. Poisons. Radio-Active Materials. Electronic Equipment which might interfere with the navigational aids of the aircraft; and other restricted articles (such as Mercury, Magnetic Material, Offensive or irritating Materials). Further information is available on request.

SMOKING. On AIR ANGLIA aircraft cigarette smoking is permitted and you may carry a box of matches or a lighter with you for use on the journey. The use of book matches is prohibited on Air Anglia aircraft.

CONNECTIONS. Air Anglia assumes no responsibility for making connections with other carriers whether or not published in the Air Anglia Timetable.

All Air Anglia services operated by Fokker Friendship or Piper Navajo Aircraft.

INFORMATION ON DOMESTIC FARES

NO SHOW CHARGES. A charge of £5.00 (or full fare if less than £5.00) will be made when a passenger fails to cancel his reservation and does not join the flight on which he is booked.

CHILDREN AND INFANTS. One infant under three years of age accompanied by an adult passenger and not occupying a separate seat is permitted to travel FREE of charge. Infants under three years of age in excess of one infant as above, and infants under three years of age occupying separate seats, and children of three years and under twelve years of age, may travel at 50% of the adult fare.

UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN. Children between the ages of 6 and 12 may travel unaccompanied with the permission of their parents or guardian. In the child's interests AIR ANGLIA requires that he/she be escorted to the airport of departure and met at the airport of arrival, and that the name and address of the escort be given at the time of reservation. If accepted for travel an unaccompanied child under six years of age will pay the full adult fare in addition to 50% of the fare when an escort is provided by AIR ANGLIA.

YOUNG PERSONS REDUCED FARES. (not available to and/or from the Channel Islands). A discount of 25% off the applicable normal fares may be granted to young persons for travel wholly on U.K. domestic services. A "Young Person" is defined as a person who at the commencement of travel has reached his/her twelfth but not his/her twentieth second birthday. If necessary these passengers may be requested to confirm their age by production of a birth certificate or other similar document.

STUDENTS. A discount of 25% off the applicable normal one-way, round trip return fare will be granted to students of 12 years of age and under 26 years of age at the date of commencement of the outward journey, provided that he/she is pursuing for at least one school year a full time educational, vocational, technical or nurses' training course and submits a duly authorised certificate from the educational establishment. This facility is only available for travel between place of education and home.

GROUP TRAVEL. A party of twelve or more fare paying passengers travelling together wholly on U.K. Domestic Services may be allowed a discount of 10% off the applicable normal, excursion, student or young persons reduced fares. This discount will not apply if a tour conductor of the group is being allowed free or reduced travel.

FARES FOR BLIND PERSONS AND ACCOMPANYING ATTENDANTS. A rebate of 50% off the applicable tourist-class fare shall be allowed to an adult blind person, accompanied by another adult, travelling for business, medical, training, education or rehabilitation purposes, on production of an appropriate certificate completed by the Ministry of Social Security or a recognised organisation for the blind. No charge will be made for the carriage of a properly harnessed dog trained to lead a blind person when it accompanies a blind person who is dependant upon such a dog.

INFORMATION ON INTERNATIONAL FARES

CANCELLATION CHARGES. Cancellations should always be made as far in advance as possible. Cancellations or short notice may be subject to certain charges at the discretion of the carrier.

NO SHOW CHARGES. Should a passenger fail to appear for a flight by the official check-in time a no show charge will be levied. This charge will be 25% of the one-way fare. Minimum charge - £5.00 or full fare, whichever is less.

CHILDREN AND INFANTS. One child under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat, is carried at 10% of the adult fare. Additional children under two years of age and children of two years and under twelve years of age are carried at 50% of the adult fare.

UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN. Children between the ages of 6 and 12 may travel unaccompanied with the permission of their parent or guardian. In the child's interests AIR ANGLIA requires that he/she be escorted to the airport of departure and met at the airport of arrival, and that the name and address of the escort be given at the time of reservation.

YOUNG PERSONS REDUCED FARES. A discount of not more than 25% of the applicable normal tourist one-way, round trip, or circle trip fare may be granted to Young Persons for travel to most European countries. A Young Person is defined as a person who at the time of travel has reached his/her 12th but not his/her 22nd birthday. Travel at these fares is permitted at any time of the year and ticket validity is one year. Combination with other fares is not permitted but Common Interest Group Travel may be applied where applicable. No other discount may be applied to the fares but normal baggage regulations will apply. If necessary, passengers may be requested to confirm their age by production of a birth certificate or other similar documents.

STUDENTS. The above Young Persons reduced fare facilities may also be extended to Students between 22 and 25 years of age inclusive at the date of commencement of the outward journey provided that he/she is pursuing for at least one school year a full-time educational, vocational, technical or nurses' training course, and submits a duly authorised certificate from the educational establishment. Travel need not be confined to between place of education and home.

GROUP TRAVEL. When a party of ten or more adult members (Two children at half-fare counts as one adult) of a sports club, society or other similar group travel together to the same destination a rebate will be granted on receipt of a written application well before the date of travel. The amount of the rebate is 5% on each ticket for parties of ten to fourteen adults; 10% for parties of 15 or more. This rebate, which is available for travel between most European countries, can be applied to normal single, return, circle trip or open jaw tickets and to most excursion fares.

AIRPORT SERVICE CHARGES. At some airports charges are levied by Airport Authorities on International Services. Please enquire locally for further information.

LOST PROPERTY. The Company cannot accept responsibility for personal or other belongings left on aircraft or other Company premises. While efforts will be made to contact the owners of identifiable property, any other property will be retained for a period of 3 months and then disposed of.
