GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOKINGS

It is advisable to make all Bookings well in advance through Travel Agents or the Group's Booking Offices. Cables and telegraphic charges in respect of bookings are normally your responsibility.

RETURN AND ONWARD BOOKINGS

Return journey reservations should be checked as soon as possible after your outward journey. Similarly, if you are stopping off at any point you are requested to check your onward booking as soon as possible.

STOPOVERS

You may normally break your journey without extra charge, provided it is completed within the period of validity of your ticket and that you notify us when the booking is made. Hotel expenses are, of course, your own responsibility at voluntary stopover points.

CANCELLATION OF BOOKINGS

If you have to cancel your reservations, please let us know as soon as possible and return your ticket. We cannot guarantee any refund when reservations are cancelled at short notice or if you fail to tell us that you cannot take up your reservation.

YOUR TICKET

Your ticket is valid only for the date and flight shown thereon and, unless otherwise stated, the return validity is six months from dates of outward travel for Regional Mainline and Internal journeys within Africa. For other journeys the validity is twelve months.

LOW-COST TRAVEL

A return ticket costs less than two single fares. Also you may purchase return tickets with a rebate for journeys covering circular trips.

EXCURSION fares, ASSOCIATED GROUP TRAVEL CONCESSIONS and REDUCTIONS for STUDENTS are available in certain circumstances.

YOUR FARE INCLUDES—

Carriage by air from airport of embarkation to airport of destination, and free baggage allowance, all meals and light refreshments during flight. Hotel accommodation, meals and ground transport are usually provided at nightstops, and on transfer from the Group's services to direct connecting services up to a maximum of 24 hours.

Hotel accommodation and meals will not be provided for interline passengers at connecting points for journeys performed wholly within the area comprising:—

(a) Rhodesia, Malawi and Zambia, the Republic of South Africa and South West Africa, Portuguese East Africa, and the Republic of the Congo or

(b) East Africa and the Republic of the Congo.

Hotel accommodation at most destinations is very limited. However, any airline of the Group will, on request, assist wherever possible. Incidental expenses are payable by the passenger.

All fares shown are subject to alteration without prior notice.

AIRPORT FORMALITIES

It is important that you arrive at the Airport Weigh Bay in sufficient time to allow ticket and baggage check-in formalities to be completed at least 30 minutes before the advertised departure time for Regional and Domestic journeys, and at least 60 minutes for International journeys.

The time shown on the flight coupon is the departure time of the aircraft. The check-in time shown is the latest time at which passengers can be accepted for travel; it allows the minimum time to complete all the formalities. In your own interests you should plan to arrive at the town terminal or airport in good time as this will help to ensure that your aircraft departs on schedule. You are also advised to check local road conditions to avoid possible delay for this reason. Flights cannot be held for passengers arriving late and no responsibility can be accepted in such cases.

Road transport arrangements to the Airport are notified when tickets are purchased.

CHILDREN AND INFANTS

An infant under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat is charged 10% of the published fare.

Additional infants under two accompanying the same adult, an infant under two occupying a separate seat, and children aged two but under twelve, are charged half-fare. Age is taken as at the date of departure of the initial outward flight.

UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN

Children may travel unaccompanied, subject to certain conditions, with the permission of their parent or guardian. In the child's interest, the Group requires that he/she be escorted to the airport of departure and met at the airport of arrival and that the name and address of the escort be given at the time of reservation. Please apply to any of the Group's offices.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

We request you to take special care especially at transit stops, of personal articles and of unchecked baggage as the Airline cannot accept responsibility for them.

PASSPORTS, PERMITS AND VISAS

Please ensure that your passport is in order and that you have the necessary visas, permits and endorsements for your journey. Our staff will gladly give you any advice. Your passport is a valuable and essential document. Remember to carry it with you and not to pack it.

If you are taking and bringing your camera back you should declare it to the Customs Authorities at your point of departure.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

For travel in Africa it is advisable to have:—

(a) A valid Yellow Fever Certificate. Validity is from 12 days to 6 years from date of primary inoculation. Re-inoculations are valid at once for 6 years.

(b) A valid Smallpox Certificate. Validity of primary vaccination from 8 days to 3 years from date of certification of reaction. For re-vaccination, it is immediately effective for 3 years.

Health certificates must be of the approved international form and should be carried in your passport. Please check what is necessary for your journey.

FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Free Baggage Allowance of 20 kilos (44 lb.). Tourist: 15 kilos (33 lb.) Skycoach, is normally granted on Group services. In certain circumstances 30 kilos (66 lb.) allowance is permitted. For details please enquire at time of booking.

Baggage on "Beaver" services should be restricted to a suitcase not larger than 30 inches x 18 inches x 9 inches.

Children travelling at half-fare receive the full adult allowance, but infants travelling at 10% of the fare have no allowance. A carrycot or portable cradle is, however, included free in the child's own personal weight.

PERSONAL ITEMS

In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge: a lady's handbag, an overcoat, wrap or blanket, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars, an invalid's fully collapsible wheel chair, a pair of crutches and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight. Brief cases, typewriters, ladies' vanity cases and large cameras have to be included in the baggage weights under the regulations of the International Air Transport Association.

EXCESS BAGGAGE

Baggage in excess of your free allowance will be subject to charges per kilo of 1% of the first class single fare. If you are travelling with your family or friends, you may group your baggage and thereby benefit from the collective free allowance.

UNACCOMPANIED BAGGAGE

Heavy baggage may be shipped at half the basic (under 45 kilos) cargo rates provided that it weighs not less than 10 kilos (22 lb.).

VALUABLE BAGGAGE

You may insure your baggage against risk of loss at any of the Group's offices at very reasonable rates,

OR

If you consider the value of your baggage to be more than £5 17s. 10d. per kilo you may increase the Group's limits of liability in the event of loss by paying a valuation charge of 9d. per £25 up to a maximum of £1,500 when checking in at the airport.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE

The General Conditions of Carriage are available for inspection at any of our airline offices or at the Airport.

The Group's timetables show the local airport times of aircraft arrivals and departures but are subject to alterations without prior notice. Every effort is made to ensure punctuality of these schedules, but the airline cannot accept responsibility for any delays to or suspension of, schedules and does not guarantee connections with any other services.

GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS

Please remember that it is your responsibility to comply with Customs, Passport, Currency and Health regulations of the countries which you intend to visit or transit. Our staff will however, be pleased to advise you on any problem.
