CHILDREN'S FARES

One child under the age of two years and accompanied by a full fare paying passenger will be charged 10 per cent. of the full fare.

Any additional child under two years of age, accompanied by a full fare paying passenger, will be charged half of the full fare.

Children under two years of age occupying individual seats will be charged half of the full fare.

Children aged two years and under the age of twelve years will be charged half of the full adult fare.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Each fare-paying passenger who is not in transit from or to a Transatlantic service is allowed 20 kilos (44 lbs.) of personal effects free of charge. Each fare-paying passenger who is in transit on a through ticket from or to a Transatlantic service is allowed 30 Kilos (66 lbs.) of personal effects free of charge. In addition to this free allowance, the following articles may be carried free :—

Ladies' handbags, overcoats, rugs and wraps, umbrellas and walking sticks, small pocket cameras and binoculars.

Brief cases, typewriters and heavy cameras will be included in baggage weights.

All baggage carried in excess of the free allowance will be charged for at the following rates :—

GENERAL INFORMATION

ASSEMBLY OF PASSENGERS :

Passengers are requested to assemble at departure points fifteen minutes before times of departure.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE :

The attention of passengers and consignors is particularly drawn to the Company's Conditions of Carriage, which can be inspected at the Dublin, Shannon, London, Liverpool and Paris Airports or any of the Company's Offices, and an extract of which appears on the back of every air ticket, baggage check and consignment note issued by the Company.

SCHEDULES :

Timetables are subject to alteration or cancellation without previous notice, and the Company cannot accept liability for delays or cancellations.

CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS AND FOOD CONTROL :

Passengers are strongly recommended to keep themselves informed of the latest regulations concerning these subjects.

PASSPORTS :

Passengers must possess all documents (such as valid passports and/or certificates) if required by the laws of the countries from, into or over which they are to fly. As these regulations vary considerably, passengers should consult the Consulates of such countries before requesting reservations. Should any required documents be missing, travel will be denied. Aer Lingus will not accept responsibility for the consequences resulting from failure to comply with these requirements.

BOOKING CANCELLATIONS :

The attention of passengers is especially drawn to the Company's regulation, which provides that in the absence of 48 hours' notice of cancellation of a booking, the full fare may be forfeited or a minimum cancellation fee of 6/-, plus all costs, charged at the discretion of the Company.

REFUNDS :

The Company does not undertake to make any return to passengers in respect of the value of lost, mislaid or unused tickets or of any fares charged in consequence of a passenger's failure to produce a ticket when required. In the case of a flight being cancelled or interrupted, repayment of fare may be made in accordance with the Company's conditions of carriage. Applications for refund should be made to the Issuing Agent or to any Traffic Office of the Company within a period of thirty days from the date fixed for the journey.

VALIDITY OF RETURN TICKETS :

Return tickets are valid for a period of 60 days from the date of the outward journey.

INTERCHANGE OF TICKETS :

The return halves of rail and steamer tickets can be surrendered within their valid dates for either an air ticket or an air and rail ticket for the return journeys between Dublin and Liverpool and Dublin and London. A supplement to the original fare is payable in such cases under this arrangement. Return tickets exchangeable are : Ordinary, Monthly and Bulk Travel. This facility does not at present apply to tickets to or from Irish stations except Dublin.

Children's tickets cannot be exchanged. The air fare must be paid and a refund requested from the Railway or Shipping Company concerned.

The return half of an air ticket can be surrendered within the valid date and without extra charge for a rail and/or steamer ticket for the return journey.

On such an exchange a refund is repayable on application to this Company. The air reservation held must be cancelled before exchange.

AIR FREIGHT

Aer Lingus carries freight on its passenger services. Dimensional and costing details are published in the Company's Air Freight Tariff Folder, copies of which may be obtained from any Aer Lingus Office or from any travel or freight agent.

TRANSATLANTIC AND EUROPEAN SERVICES

Aer Lingus are agents for all Transatlantic and European Air Services. Bookings to all parts of the world may be made from any of our traffic offices.
