

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS

The 24-HOUR CLOCK system is used in this timetable

- Conditions of Carriage** An extract from the General Conditions under which passengers are carried by Imperial Airways and its Associated and Subsidiary Companies will be found in every air ticket. A copy of the General Conditions of Carriage may be inspected at any of the Company's offices or airports
- Connexions** Except as specifically provided for in the General Conditions of Carriage, the Company cannot be responsible for damage resulting from the failure of aeroplanes to depart or arrive at the times stated in timetables, nor for failure to make connexions with services operated by other air lines or other forms of transport
- Passports** A valid passport correctly endorsed and visaed must be carried by every passenger. Information about current passport and visa regulations may be obtained from any office or agent of the Company. The Company cannot be responsible for the correctness of passports or visas or for the consequences of any non-compliance with the regulations

TICKET REGULATIONS

- Fares** The fares provide for all meals and hotel accommodation (including tips) during the voyage and for the cost of all surface transport which forms part of the journey. For baggage allowance see paragraph 12 below
- Return Tickets** save money and are valid for a period of one year from the date of the outward journey, unless otherwise stated. Unused return halves may be surrendered to the Company for refund of the difference between the single and return fare, provided that the regulations regarding cancellations have been observed
- Re-booking Abatement** Passengers purchasing single tickets are given a certificate which entitles them to a rebate of 10% of the fare for a subsequent journey in the return direction over any part of the same route within twelve months
- Children** Children up to three years of age, when accompanied by an adult and when no separate seat is required for them, are carried at 10% of the full fare. Children between three and seven years of age, or younger children occupying a separate seat are carried at half fare. On certain services the Company will concede this arrangement to children up to twelve years of age. For baggage allowance see paragraph 12 below
- Reservations** must be made and accepted in advance through a travel agent or an office of the Company. Telephone or telegraphic expenses in connexion with an application will be borne by the passenger

- Provisional reservations can be made (so long as seats remain available) on payment of a deposit of 25% of the fare. Provisional reservations automatically lapse fourteen days before the journey is scheduled to begin. Within this period reservations will only be held on payment of the full fare
- Cancellations by Passenger** If the Company be notified and the ticket surrendered not less than fourteen days before the scheduled date of departure, the fare will be refunded less 10%, and less any telephone or telegraphic expenses. Within the period of fourteen days a refund, if any, will be in the discretion of the Company
- Cancellations by Company** The Company reserves the right to cancel any flight or part of a flight whenever such action is deemed advisable or necessary. In any event the passenger's sole redress shall be the recovery of the unused portion of the fare
- Combined Sea-Air Tickets** Arrangements are in force with certain steamship lines for combined sea-air journeys at reduced fares (details on application)

BAGGAGE INFORMATION

- Baggage Allowance** Each passenger is allowed 20 kilogrammes (44 lb.) of baggage without charge. Baggage in excess of this allowance is chargeable:
Up to 20 kgs. excess—half the published excess baggage rate
Over 20 kgs.—full published excess baggage rate
Children travelling at half fare receive half the above allowances. No allowance of baggage is made for children travelling at 10% of the fare

- Customs Regulations** Only personal effects may be carried as baggage. Merchandise can be carried only as freight
- Excess Baggage** The charges for baggage in excess of the free allowance are payable on embarkation. The company does not guarantee to carry excess baggage in the same aeroplane as the passenger
- Baggage in Advance** The Company will assist passengers to arrange for heavy and bulky baggage to be sent by surface transport if desired
- Labelling of Baggage** Baggage labels are issued with the passenger ticket. Every piece of baggage (small hand-baggage included) should bear one of these labels
- Baggage Required During the Journey** Personal effects required for use at night-stops should be packed in one suitcase to facilitate handling at ports. Heavy and bulky baggage cannot always be made accessible to the passenger at night-stops

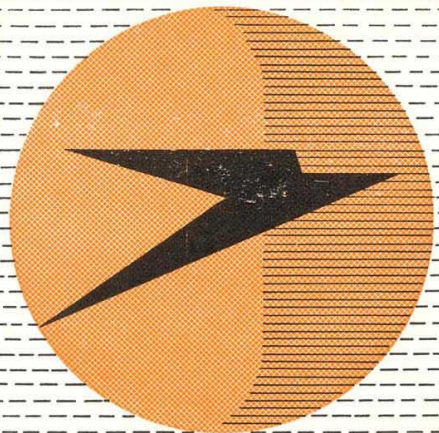
GENERAL INFORMATION

- Departure** The times of departure are liable to alteration without notice, and passengers should obtain the latest information from the Company's local representative to avoid the risk of missing the aeroplane. Passengers must arrive at the departure point sufficiently in advance of the appointed time to enable passport inspection and other formalities to be completed. The departure cannot be delayed for a passenger arriving late
- Insurance** Most Life Assurance policies include air travel. At most offices of the Company personal insurance may be effected if desired before departure at low rates. Baggage may also be insured
- Currency Coupons** To avoid changing bank notes, etc., for small purchases during the journey, passengers are advised to use the Company's currency coupons. These coupons, each valued at 5s., are sold in books of ten at £2 11s. per book. Coupons may be exchanged for their equivalent value in local currency at any office of Imperial Airways. Unused coupons will be redeemed by the Company at the end of the journey
- Smoking** Smoking is not allowed in any aircraft not provided with a special smoking saloon. When a smoking saloon is provided smoking is not allowed in any other part of the same aircraft, and at any time passengers must cease to smoke if asked to do so by an official of the Company
- Quarantine** In the event of existing or anticipated quarantine restrictions the Commander of the aircraft may, at his discretion, omit to call at any station. The Company cannot be responsible for any delay, inconvenience or loss which may result. In the event of 'over-carriage' arising in consequence thereof the passenger may be called upon to pay any additional expenses which the Company incurs
- Inoculation and Vaccination** Passengers proceeding to or through certain countries are required to possess certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination. Full particulars may be obtained from any office of the Company
- Firearms and Wireless Apparatus** Certain countries restrict or prohibit the importation or carriage of firearms and wireless apparatus. Passengers intending to take with them or to carry these things should obtain details of the regulations from the Company. Carriage of ammunition, explosives, or any form of combustible material is prohibited
- Cameras** The carriage of cameras, even when packed in baggage, is prohibited over some countries. Where these restrictions apply passengers will be asked to hand their cameras to an official of the Company. The cameras will be carried under Customs seal over the prohibited area, and afterwards returned to their owners
- Freight** in limited quantities can usually be accepted for carriage on the Empire Services at the rates shown in this timetable. The basis of charge is per half kilogramme with a minimum charge as for one kilogramme
- Live Stock** No live animals of any kind can be carried on the Empire passenger services
