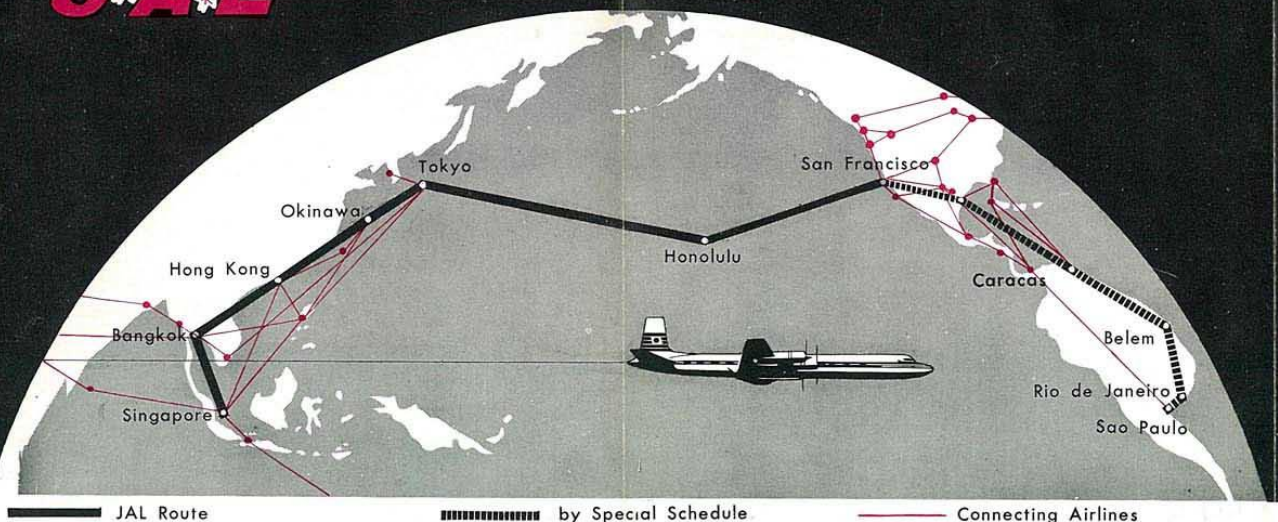
ROUTE OF THE SUPER COURIER

RESERVATION

Reservations must be made in advance. Call your travel agent or any JAL office to obtain airline reservations necessary for your complete journey.

Reconfirmation: If you are holding confirmed reservation in advance and making stopovers in North America or Europe, you must reconfirm reservation by the following deadlines. Failure to do so will, by applicable regulations, result in cancellation of all of your onward and return reservations and such space will be made available to someone else.

To reconfirm, simply inform at each boarding point the airlines on which you are booked to depart from that point. This may be done by any expedient means—in person, by telephone, telegram, cable or mail.

TICKETS

Validity: Tickets issued at normal fares are valid one year from the date of commencement of journey, or if no portion of the ticket has been used, one year from the date of issue.

Stopover: Stopovers at any scheduled stop or connecting point may be arranged at the time ticket is purchased.

Children: For children two years of age or over, but under twelve, one-half adult fare will apply. Infant under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a seat, will be carried at 10% of the adult fare, but one-half adult fare will apply to any such infant in excess of one.

Air/Sea Travel: Arrangement may be made for travel partly via air and partly via sea.

Sleeper: Sleeper berth is available on first class at an additional charge of US \$75.00.

CHECK-IN TIME

Before departure, passengers must arrive at the airport or town terminal not later than following check-in times prior to the scheduled departure of flights.

BAGGAGE

When packing, special care should be given not to include following articles in checked baggage: fragile and perishable articles, money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers, securities or other valuables, samples or business documents. Inflammable articles, explosive or evil-smelling material etc. must not be carried on board aircraft.

Free Baggage Allowance: 30 kilos (66 lbs.) for first class fare paying passenger; 20 kilos (44 lbs.) for tourist class or excursion fare paying passenger. Children paying one-half adult fare are entitled to the same baggage allowance with adult fare paying passengers. Infants paying 10% of the adult fare are not entitled to free baggage allowance.

A lady's handbag or pocket book, an overcoat or wrap a foot rug, an umbrella or walking-stick, a small camera and a pair of binoculars, a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight, infant's food for consumption en route and infant's carrying basket are carried free over and above the free baggage allowance. However, overnight bag, briefcase, lady's vanity case, portable typewriter, large size camera, and portable radio must be weighed and included in the free baggage allowance.

Excess Baggage: Baggage in excess of the free baggage allowance may be carried (1) as excess baggage at a charge of 1% of the normal adult first class one-way fare per kilo, or (2) as unaccompanied baggage at reduced cargo rates.

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

Passport: When you travel abroad, a valid passport, or an official document in lieu thereof, is required (1) to permit you to leave your country, (2) to enter other countries and (3) to prove your right to return to your country.

Visa: A visa is a stamp of approval to be affixed on your passport by a consular official, permitting you to enter the country you visit. Most countries require that your passport be properly visaed for entry into or transit through such countries. Alien residents returning to their country of residence are required of re-entry permit or visa.

Photographs: Many consulates require front view, passport size photographs for issuance of visas. Some countries require photographs to be submitted to the immigration authorities upon arrival.

Health Certificate: Many countries require that you have proper vaccinations and inoculations prior to arrival. Such vaccinations must be recorded on the "International Certificate of Vaccination" form and certified by a national, state, country or municipal health authority. The form is available at any such office, your travel agent or JAL office.

CURRENCY

Since many governments restrict amount of cash to be taken into or out of their countries, travellers are recommended to carry a small amount of cash (only sufficient to meet immediate expenses) and the rest in the form of traveller's cheques or letter of credit.

INSURANCE

Personal and baggage insurances are available at your travel agent or airlines office.

HOTELS

Hotel reservations may be arranged in advance through your travel agent or airlines offices.

MEALS

Complimentary meals served aloft or at intermediate airports at meal times. Snack and beverages services available aloft at all times. Wines, beer and spirits free of charge on first class and for sale on tourist class at reasonable prices.

BABIES, SICK OR INCAPACITATED PASSENGERS

Special facilities are available on board for passengers travelling with babies, or for sick and incapacitated passengers. Please make arrangements in advance.
