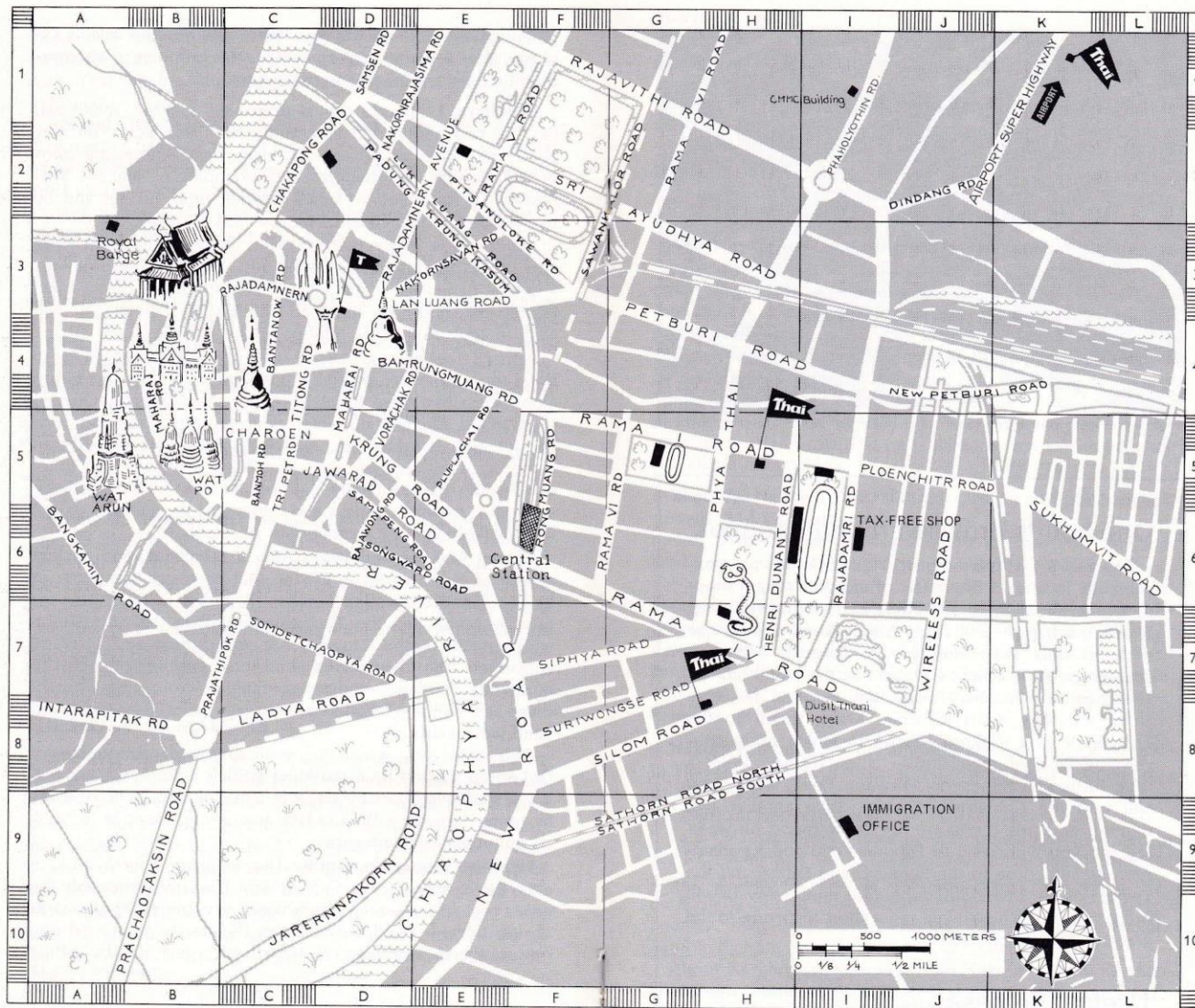


Bangkok
