### Belgium.

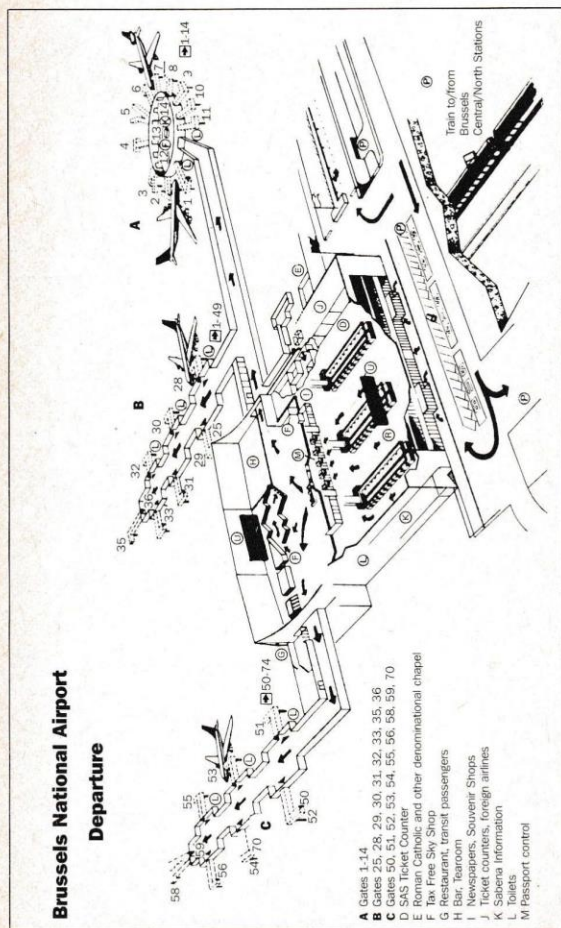
Name: Brussels National Airport.

Location: 12 km (7½ miles) northeast of Brussels city center, 40 km (25 miles) south of Antwerp.

Other local airports: Deurne, 6 km (3½ miles) from Antwerp.

### Luxembourg.

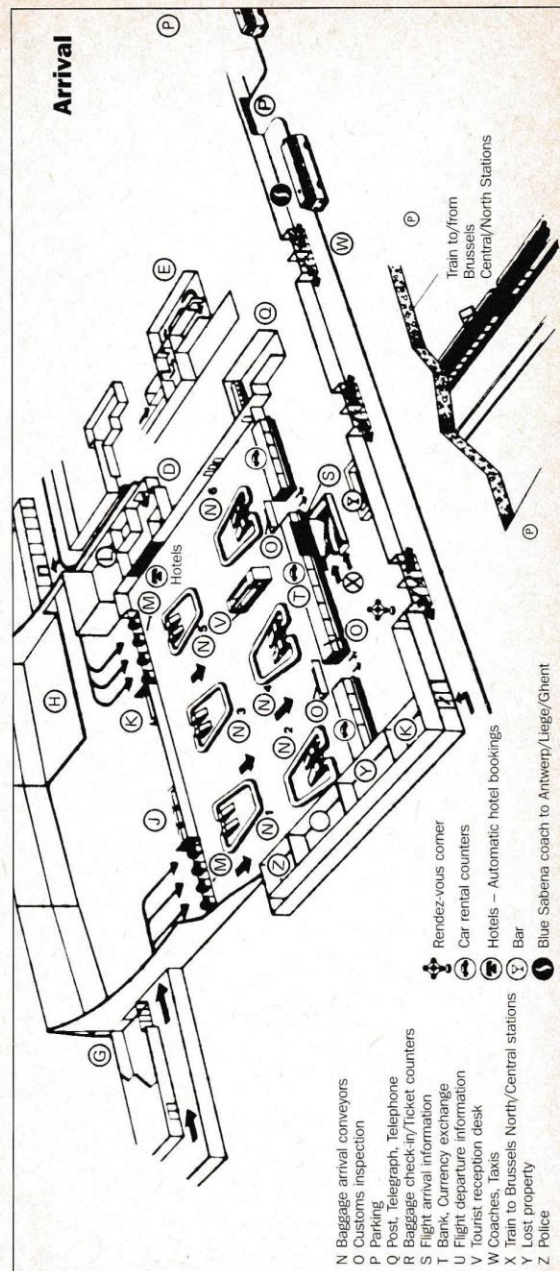
Name: Findel, 6 km (3½ miles) from Luxembourg City.

**Your arrival in Brussels.**

After leaving your SAS plane at National Airport, you proceed to passport control.

Your luggage is inspected in the Customs Hall. Spare luggage may be left at the airport. Inside the Customs Hall you will find banks with currency exchange facilities, as well as telephone and telegraph offices. The Post Office is situated outside the Customs Hall.

Trains to town depart from the platform just below the Arrival Hall. They leave every 30 minutes to the Brussels Central Station with an intermediate stop at the North Station. The fare is BFR60 in second class and BFR75 in first class. Tickets should be purchased at the Railways Ticket Counter before boarding the train.

Taxis are also available just outside the Arrival Hall. The fare to the city center is about BFR900–1,000 (including the empty return). The trip by both train and taxi takes about 20 minutes.

If you have ordered a car, contact the car rental companies in the Arrival Hall. Information and assistance regarding hotel reservations, car hire etc. can be obtained from the Information Office or from the SAS Ticket Counter in the Departure Hall.

**Your arrival in Antwerp.**

If you arrive in Belgium via Brussels' National Airport, you proceed as mentioned above to Brussels North Station, where you can take a train to Antwerp. The trip takes about 40 minutes and tickets can be bought at the Railways Ticket Counter at Brussels Airport. You will arrive at the Central Station. There are also bus connections from Brussels' National Airport to Antwerp. Every hour from 06.00 until 22.00 hrs. Fare for this trip is BFR160 (children BFR80). Duration is approx. 50 minutes.

If your port of entry is Antwerp Airport (Deurne), you will be directed to the Security Counter for the usual passport and customs controls. You will find your luggage in the Customs Hall.

There is a bus service into Antwerp (line 16). Taxi transportation for the 6 km (3½-mile) journey costs BFR500.

**Your arrival in Luxembourg.**

After leaving your plane at Findel Airport (6 km – 3½ miles from Luxembourg City), you will be directed to the Security Counter for passport control. If you have nothing to declare, use the green exit. If you have goods to declare, use the red exit. There is a tourist information desk, as well as bank, post and telegraph offices in the Arrival Hall. There are also car hire services. Buses depart for Luxembourg City from just outside the Arrival Hall, leaving several times a day, arriving at the Town Terminal 20 minutes later. Fare: LFR80. Taxis are also available outside the Arrival Hall, the fare to the town center being approx. LFR400. Information and assistance regarding hotel reservations can be obtained at the Information desks of the Luxembourg National Tourist Office at the Air Terminal, located near the Central Station, some 15 minutes from the center of town, and at the Airport.

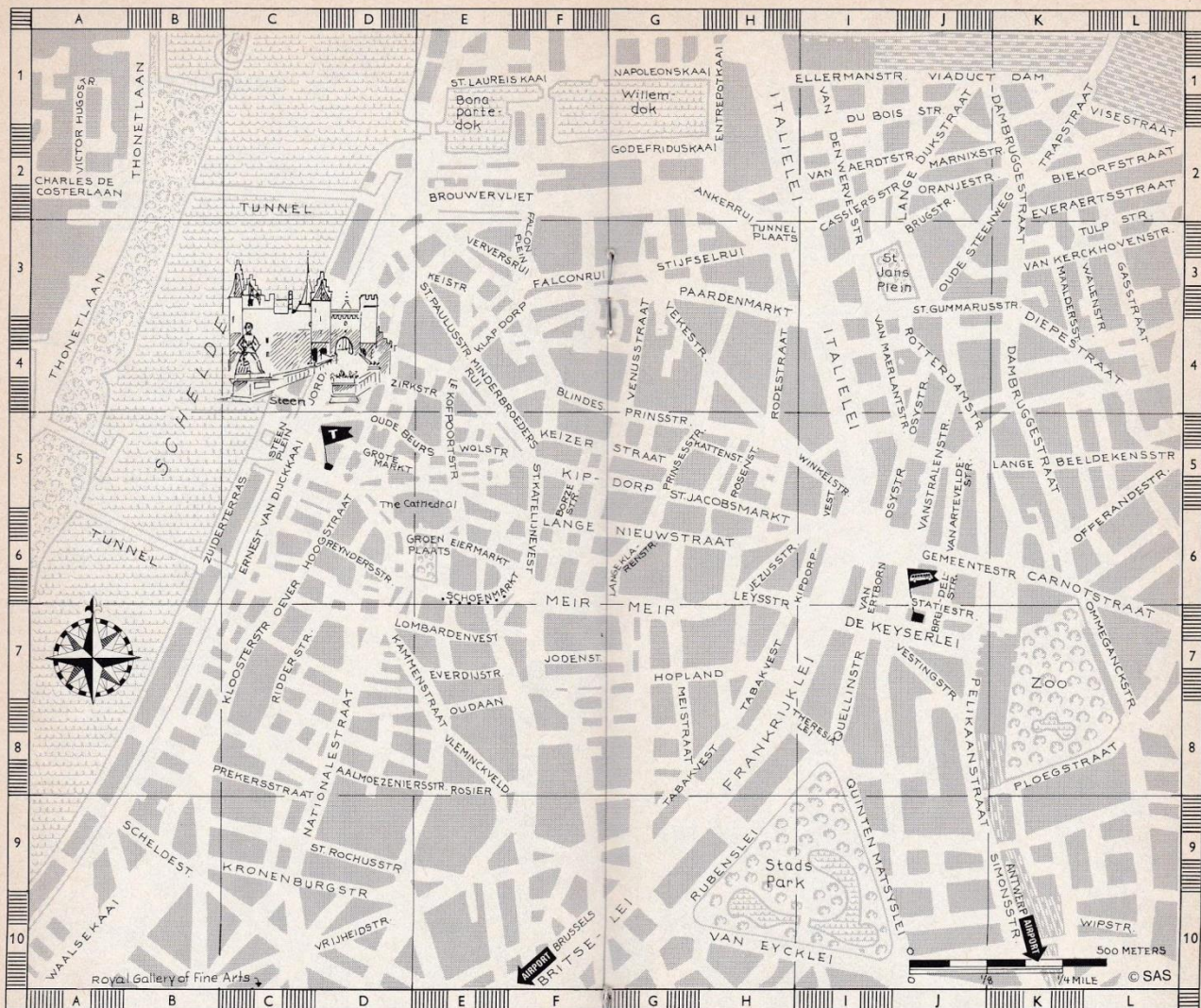

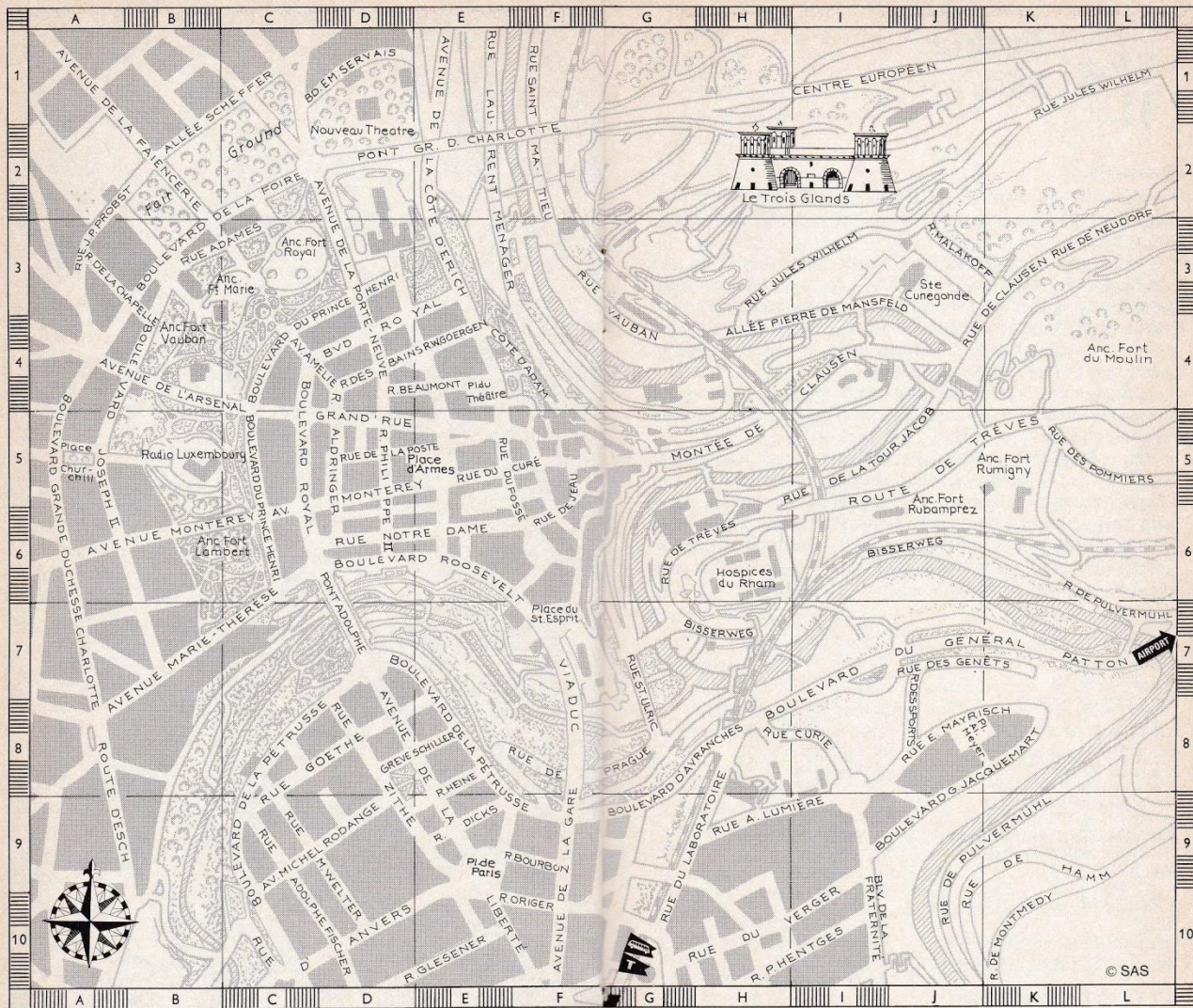

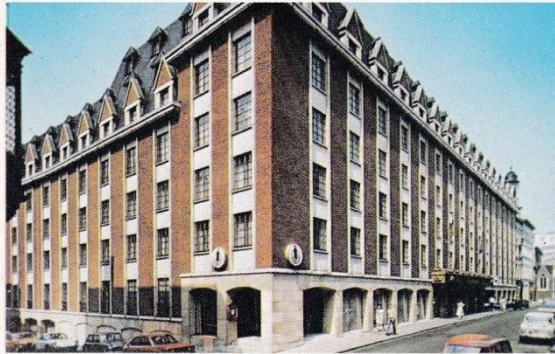
