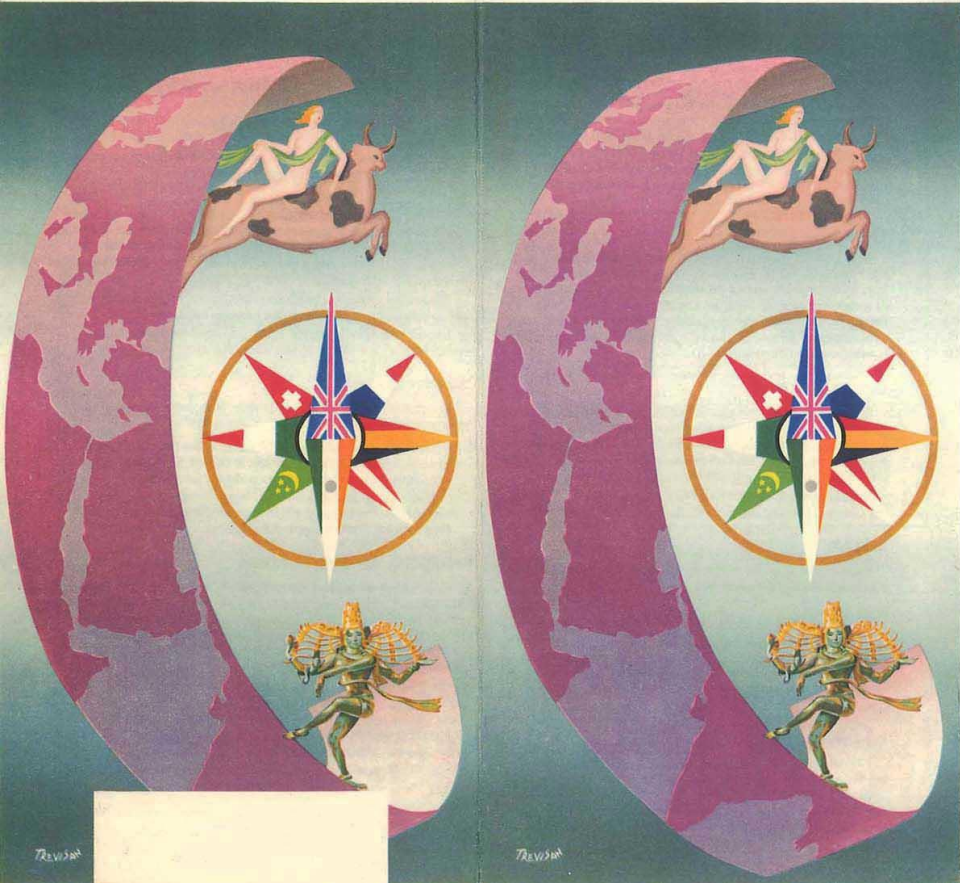

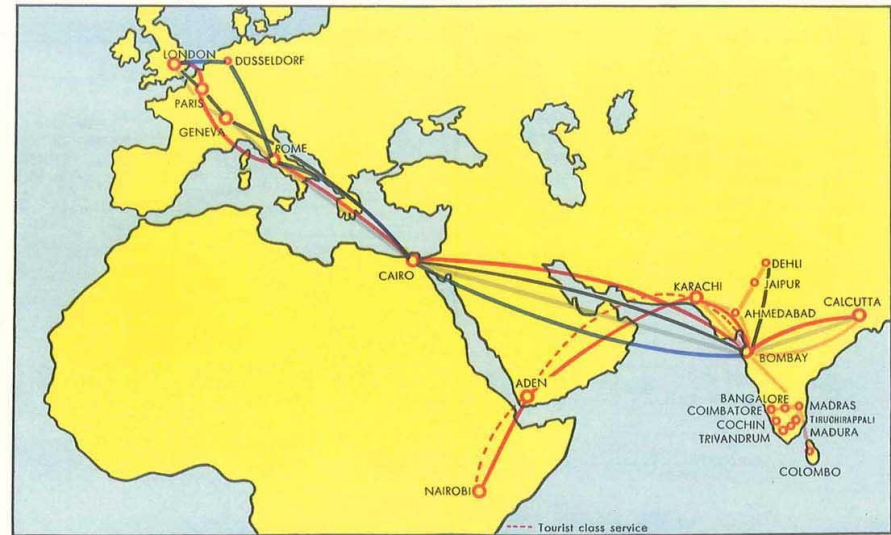

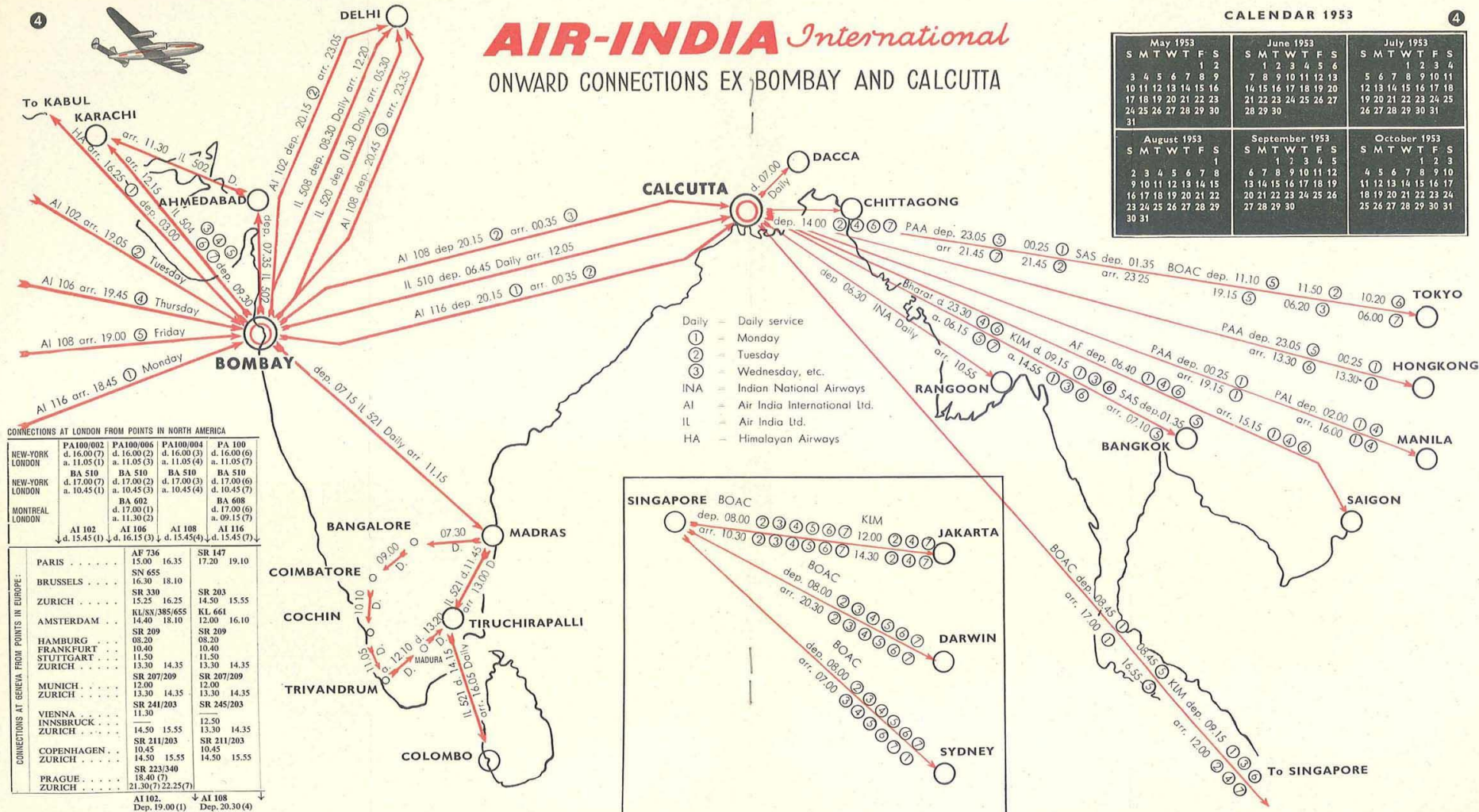

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS



RESERVATIONS

To ensure your passage on the required date, a reservation should be made and fare paid well in advance. At destination or transfer points you are advised to check return or onward reservations.

Definite return bookings can be arranged at all stations if a request is made sufficiently in advance. Return tickets for definite or open date bookings can be purchased in advance at a reduction of 20% on the return portion of the ticket. Return tickets are valid for a period of one year only. Communication expenses incurred in cancelling onward, connecting or return reservations will be collected in full.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

A. I. I. or its Agents will gladly provide information regarding Passports, Travel Permits or Visas required for your journey, but you must ensure personally that these documents are in order, because the carrier cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of any irregularity. You will have to show your passport or permit during your journey, so please carry it with you; do not permit it!

CANCELLATION

In the event of a passenger cancelling or altering his passage within 72 hours prior to the scheduled departure, the Company reserves to itself the right to charge a minimum service charge which will be 25% of the fare or the equivalent of £25/- which ever is less subject to a minimum of £2/-.

Communication expenses and any other charges incurred by the Company will be deducted from the amount to be refunded.

REFUND

Refund will only be made in the country and currency in which the original payment was made.

DEPARTURES CANNOT BE DELAYED

Passengers reporting direct to the airport in their own transport must arrive there sufficiently in advance of the time of departure to allow for the completion of the necessary formalities. Under no circumstances will a service be delayed for passengers arriving late.

CHILDREN'S FARES

The passenger fare for infants under 2 years of age not occupying individual seats is 10% of the adult fare. Only one child under 2 years of age and not occupying a separate seat will be carried at such 10% of the adult fare provided the adult fare has been paid for the accompanying parent or guardian and that

not more than one such child is transported with each accompanying parent or guardian. A ticket is required for each such child.

The passenger fare is 50% of the adult fare for:—

- Children who have reached their second birthday but have not yet reached their twelfth birthday.
- Infants under two years of age occupying individual seats, and
- Infants under two years of age in excess of the one accompanying a passenger paying the adult fare.

BAGGAGE

The free baggage allowance per passenger who pays the adult fare, or infants and children travelling on half fare tickets is 30 kgs., except for travel wholly in Europe where free baggage allowance is only 20 kgs.

Infants on whom the passenger fare is 10% of the applicable adult fare will be granted no free baggage allowance.

Excess baggage is carried subject to load and space being available and is charged at the scheduled excess baggage rates.

PERSONAL ITEMS

In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge:—

a lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, a foot rug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight.

Brief cases, typewriters and large cameras have to be included in the baggage weights under the regulations of the International Air Transport Association.

STUDENTS EXCURSION FARE

(i) Students who have reached their 12th but not their 26th birthday will be carried at the one way normal fare for the round trip journey. If however, the inward and outward portions of the return journey are not equal, the fare will be 50% of the sum of the normal one way fares for the inward and outward journeys.

(ii) Application should be made by the student's parents in writing supported by a certificate from the School or College Principal or a competent educational authority certifying that the student will be making a return air journey and will be travelling between home and school.

(iii) The tickets are valid for a period of one year.

(iv) The normal free baggage allowance and excess baggage charges will apply.

(v) Stopover privileges are not included.
