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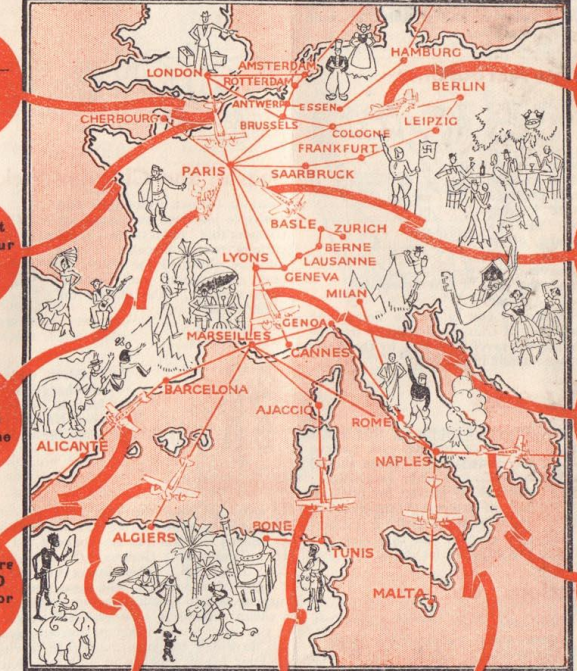
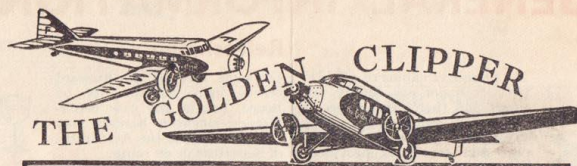

GENERAL INFORMATION

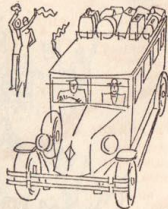
Clothing



The passenger cabins of all AIR UNION liners are totally enclosed and therefore no special clothing is required. On cold days the cabins are heated and rugs and footmuffs provided. There is adequate means of ventilation and a toilet on each machine.

Getting to the Aerodrome

You arrive at the Town office 10 to 15 minutes before the time of departure so that the Baggage Clerk can weigh you and your baggage. In London your passport is collected and returned to you at the Aerodrome. Baggage is stowed in a smart looking car waiting outside, and as soon as you are aboard, off it goes for the Aerodrome. But please be early! It saves that last minute rush—and the car must leave on time. . . . At your destination another car drives you in to the Town, and both these services are free of charge. Facilities may be arranged for your friends to travel with you to the Aerodrome if there is a space vacant in the car.



Reservation of Seats



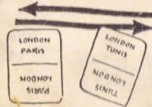
The office supplying this leaflet can issue tickets and reserve accommodation. Seats should be booked as early as possible; there is no charge for booking but on reserving long-distance flights at short notice it is sometimes necessary to telegraph abroad. In this case the passenger is charged for the expense incurred.

Train Connections, etc.

This time-table has been carefully prepared but times are naturally subject to alteration by the Companies concerned. Confirmation of the times of the services required should therefore be obtained before departure.



Return Tickets



Considerable reductions are made in return fares. Seats for the homeward voyage must be reserved for a specific service; this can be done either when taking the ticket, or at the town of destination.

Refreshments

On some services the Steward serves light refreshments on board, but in any case breakfast or luncheon baskets may be purchased at the Aerodrome of departure or en route.



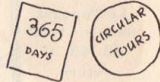
Parcels



AIR UNION maintains an efficient freight service and parcels, etc., may be despatched by air to nearly every country in the world.

Season and Circular Tickets

Season ticket vouchers for multiple journeys are issued at considerable reductions. On certain routes circular tickets may be obtained for travel to one destination and return from another. Particulars on application.



Children



Children under 3 years of age are charged 10% of the standard fare, or from 3 to 7 years half fare. No free baggage is allowed when these reductions are made.

Baggage

15 kilos (33 lbs.—the kilo being almost 2½ lbs.) of free baggage are allowed you and above this you pay excess as follows:—Paris and Le Touquet, 6d. per kilo; Lyons, 1/1; Cannes, 2/-; Geneva, 1/7; Marseilles, 1/6; Ajaccio, 2/4; Tunis, 3/6. When flying it is well to remember that a light fibre suitcase will save you money and it will surprise you to find how many clothes can be packed into a cheap expanding case and still weigh less than 33 lbs. If you have heavy baggage you are recommended to use the three-day baggage-in-advance service. We will pick up your heavy luggage in advance, deliver it if you are flying to one of the towns we serve directly, or if not, have it waiting for you at the Aerodrome of arrival. You should address it clearly and hand us the keys so that we can clear it through Customs for you. The contents will be perfectly safe, as it will only be opened during Customs inspection. If you wish you can insure your luggage very cheaply.

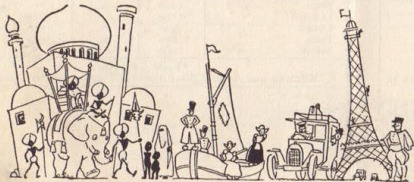

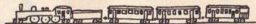
