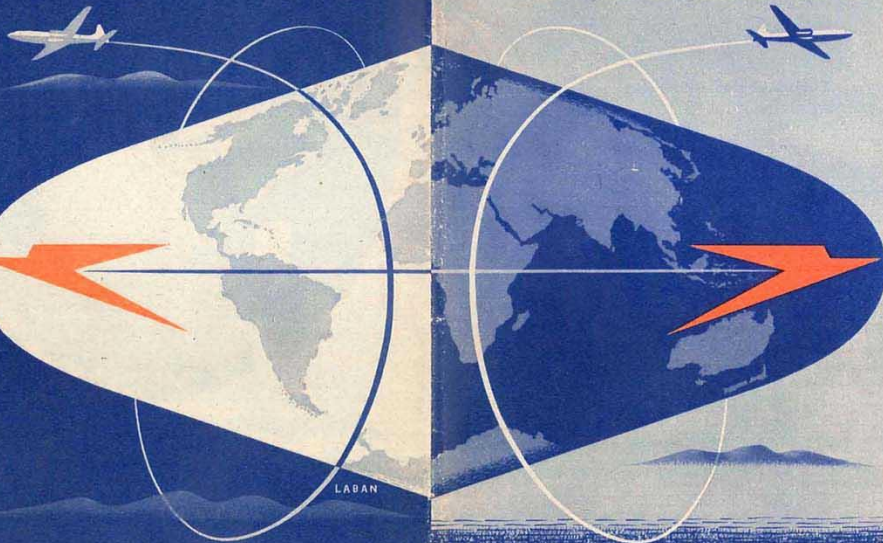

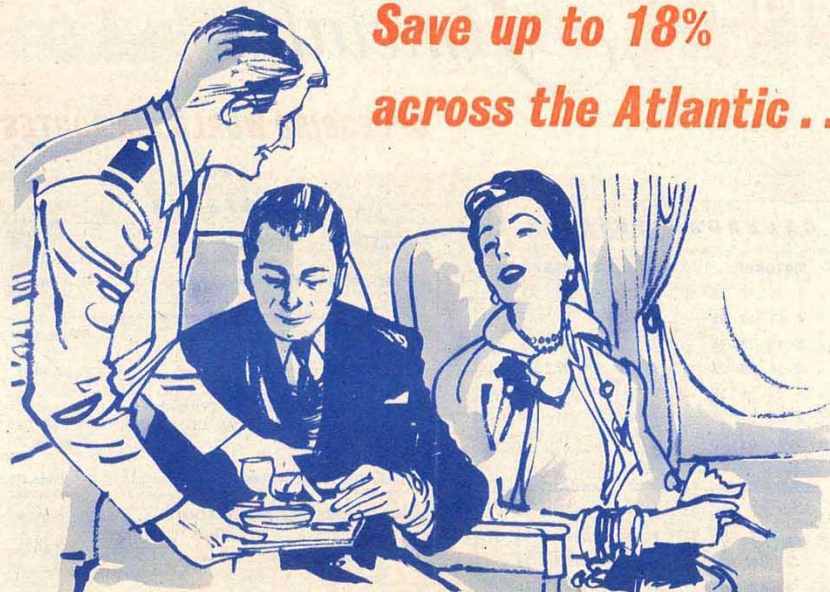

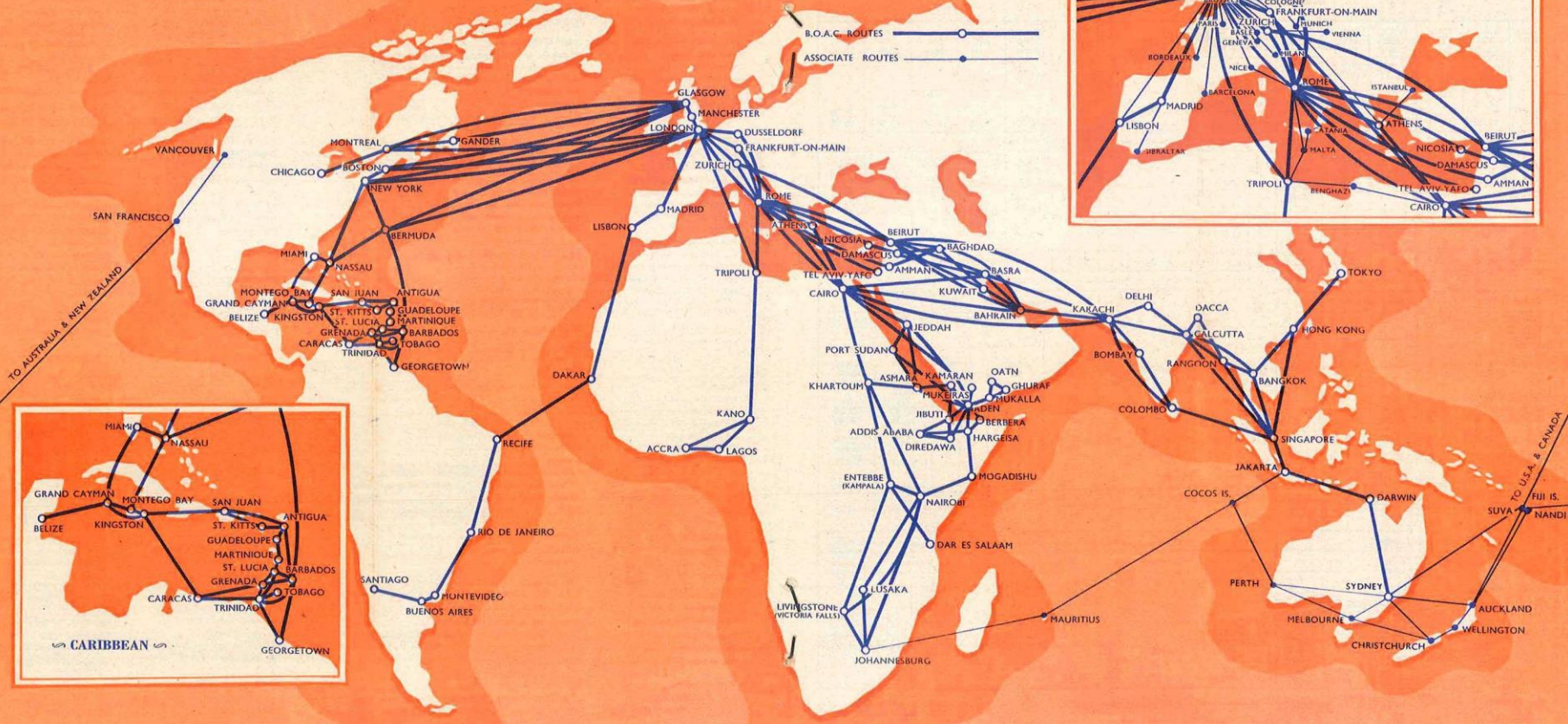

YOUR TICKET AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT Your ticket is issued subject to these Regulations and to our General Conditions of Carriage of Passengers and Baggage. These Conditions are exhibited in full at all B.O.A.C. offices and extracts can be found in your ticket.

YOUR FARE INCLUDES

Meals On B.O.A.C. services your fare includes all meals and gratuities in flight and on the ground from the departure of the aircraft until arrival at the airport of destination shown on the flight coupon of your ticket. Meals on Tourist services are of a simpler nature than those on First Class services.

Hotel Accommodation Hotel accommodation, meals and ground transport are usually provided at nightstops and on transfer from B.O.A.C. services to direct connecting services (up to a maximum of 48 hours). In other circumstances the provision of these facilities is at the option of the carrier conveying the passenger to the connecting point; they are not provided in the U.S.A. for travel to and from points in that country. Regulations for journeys by local carriers may differ, particularly in respect of baggage allowances, meals and hotel accommodation.

GROUND TRANSPORT Transport between town terminal and airport or points served by B.O.A.C. is charged for in the Western Hemisphere but is provided free in the Eastern Hemisphere (excluding U.K., Europe, Basra and Kuwait).

STOPOVERS Except when precluded by Government order, you may break your journey at one or more places en route, and retain the benefit of the through fare, provided notice is given at the time of reservation. Hotel expenses at each stopover will be your responsibility.

REDUCED FARES RETURN TICKETS, First or Tourist Class, cost approximately 10% less than two single fares and are normally valid for one year. Reductions of approximately 10% are made on certain routes for CIRCLE TRIPS, ROUND-THE-WORLD-TOURS, and "OPEN-JAW" JOURNEYS, i.e. those with return from a point different from the destination on the outward journey, or return to a point different from the place of original departure. EXCURSION and "OFF-SEASON" fares, and reductions for SCHOLARS and STUDENTS are also available in certain circumstances. Interchange arrangements between B.O.A.C. and most other air carriers enable passengers to use the combined services at the normal THROUGH FARES.

CHILDREN AND INFANTS An infant under two accompanied by an adult, and not occupying a separate seat, is charged 10% of the normal First or Tourist adult fare. Additional infants under two accompanying the same adult, an infant under two occupying a separate seat, and children of two years of age and over, who have not yet reached their twelfth birthday, are charged 50% of the normal First or Tourist adult fare. Age is taken as that at the beginning of the outward journey. Unaccompanied children under the age of seven are not normally accepted for travel. If you are travelling with children or infants, ask for our leaflet "Babies as Air Travellers". Any requirements should be advised at the time of booking.

PASSPORTS, PERMITS AND VISAS Any B.O.A.C. or Travel Agent's office will gladly assist you to obtain the travel documents required for your journey. Some Consulates, however, insist on personal attendance.

HEALTH REGULATIONS Valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination, issued on a special international form, are definitely required by most countries.

TAXES OR CHARGES Any ticket, transportation or other taxes or charges imposed by Government regulations are additional to the fare and payable by you, either with the fare or in local currency on arrival or departure.

CURRENCY Our London offices, some overseas offices and Travel Agents supply Travellers' Cheques encashable in the Sterling Area. Applications for cheques encashable outside the Sterling Area must be made through your bankers or certain Travel Agents.

B.O.A.C. Currency Coupons are invaluable as small change for purchases aboard B.O.A.C., Qantas, S.A.A. or B.E.A. aircraft, and for encashment (with a few exceptions) at nightstops or transit points in the Sterling Area. As a rule, encashment is limited elsewhere to 10% at a stop of several hours and 30% at a nightstop. Currency Coupons are not valid in Argentina, Brazil, Indonesia, Israel and Spain.

BAGGAGE

Free Allowance On First Class services the free baggage allowance is 30 kilos (66 lbs.). On Tourist and Coach Class services it is 20 kilos (44 lbs.). Passengers travelling part-way First Class, part-way Tourist Class are given the free baggage allowance applicable to the class of travel used. However, when a First Class fare has been paid and a Tourist Class service is used as part of the through journey, the First Class free baggage allowance may be carried over that sector, without additional charge. Personal articles, i.e. a lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, a foot rug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, binoculars and reading matter for the flight may be carried free. Brief cases, cabin bags, attaché cases, parcels, typewriters and heavy cameras are weighed as part of

your free allowance. If this is exceeded, you become liable to excess charges.

Excess Charges Baggage in excess of the free allowance is charged at 1% of the First Class single fare per kilo. When a First or Tourist class through fare is paid, through charges are payable at the point of origin. Separate regulations apply to "Mixed" class travel, i.e. a combination of Tourist and First Class.

Children and Infants Children at half fare get the adult allowance. Infants travelling at 10% fare have no free allowance, but a carry-cot and infant's food for consumption en route, may be carried without charge.

Excess Value Charge If no declaration of value for registered or un-registered baggage is made, it is presumed not to exceed £36 (U.S. \$100) in which case no valuation charge applies. Baggage declared to be worth more than £36 (U.S. \$100) is subject to a charge on the excess value of 9d. per £25 (or 15 cents per U.S. \$100) or fraction thereof. The maximum declaration per passenger is limited to £1,500 (U.S. \$4,200).

Unaccompanied Baggage On some routes, special rates are available for the carriage of unaccompanied baggage, i.e. wearing apparel (but excluding jewellery and furs). For a minimum quantity of 10 kilos (22 lbs.), the rate charged is only 50% of the basic freight rate per kilo.

Cameras Over certain sectors of your journey restrictions may be applied to the use of cameras and binoculars.

Domestic Animals On certain services domestic pets may be carried provided arrangements are made in advance.

Prohibited Articles Government regulations do not permit the carriage of inflammable or explosive material in aircraft. Articles which are easily ignited, such as cigarette lighter fluid, matches, etc., must not be packed in baggage or carried personally. However, where smoking is allowed on aircraft you may carry safety matches or a lighter on your person.

PUNCTUALITY While every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of our services, B.O.A.C. cannot accept responsibility for the delay or suspension of a service, nor guarantee that connections will be made with other air services or surface carriers.

YOUR DEPARTURE It is essential to report to the departure terminal or airport no later than the time advised. This allows the MINIMUM time to complete all formalities. Flights cannot be delayed for passengers arriving late and we cannot accept responsibility in such cases.

CANCELLATIONS Passengers who do not travel on the service for which they hold a reservation, and who have not cancelled in advance, are liable to payment of a "no-show" charge. Refund of fare for reservations cancelled or transferred at short notice cannot be guaranteed.

SEAT RESERVATIONS Reservation of specific seats in aircraft cannot be guaranteed, although at terminal stations on First Class services, every effort will be made to meet passengers' requirements.

COMBINED AIR/SEA JOURNEYS Arrangements exist with certain steamship companies for combined air/sea journeys. For pre-booked passengers or in cases of transfer en route, fare adjustments will be made as necessary. Special facilities for sending heavy baggage by sea are available to air passengers.

WE ADVISE YOU TO

- ★ BOOK EARLY and confirm onward or return reservations at destination and transfer points.
- ★ Save money by purchasing all tickets for your journey before departure.
- ★ Let us know your contact address or telephone number up to departure time.
- ★ Book your hotel accommodation at destination well in advance.
- ★ Pack all you need during flight in a small cabin bag. All other articles should be packed in registered baggage, one case containing all that is required at nightstops. Cabin baggage should be kept to a minimum.
- ★ Carry your Passport, Health Certificates and Currency with you. Do not pack them!
- ★ Carry any valuables, such as jewellery, personally whenever possible.
- ★ Check the "Message Board" on arrival. If friends are meeting you, give them your service and flight number.
- ★ See your B.O.A.C. APPOINTED TRAVEL AGENT. He is there to help and advise you.
