

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**BAGGAGE**—Forty (40) pounds of baggage, whether carried in cabin or checked, will be carried free on any ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds will be carried subject to load on all flights and shall be at the rate per pound of one-half of 1 per cent of the published one-way passenger fare, with a minimum charge of 2%.

**CHILDREN**—One child, under two years of age and not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each accompanying passenger 12 years of age or over. Children under two years of age for whom seats are reserved and children two years of age and under 12, will be charged one-half of the applicable adult fare.

**OPEN-JAW ROUND-TRIP TICKETS**—A 10% discount from the sum of the one-way fares is allowed on tickets issued to or from Akron or Youngstown with return passage to or from either point.

**RESERVATIONS**—All space is reserved, though no definite seat assignments are made. Reservations will not be held unless tickets are purchased three hours in advance of scheduled departure time.

**TICKETS**—A 10% reduction from the sum of the one-way fares is allowed when round-trip or circle-trip tickets are purchased before start of original trip. Return coupon must be used within four months of date of issuance. A discount of 15% from the published one-way fares is allowed when tickets are purchased under the Universal Air Travel Plan. Passengers desiring to purchase tickets on credit and pay later may do so on an installment plan.

**TIME TABLES**—This time table shows the times at which planes may be expected to depart from and arrive at the several stations shown and to connect with other planes, but their departure, arrival or connection at the time stated is not guaranteed. 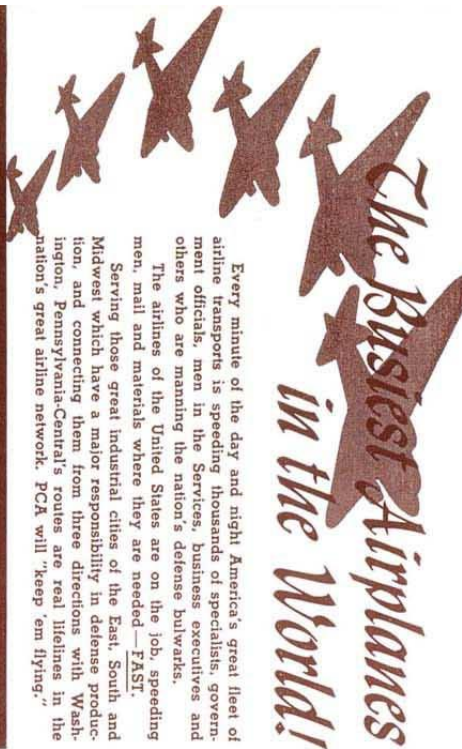

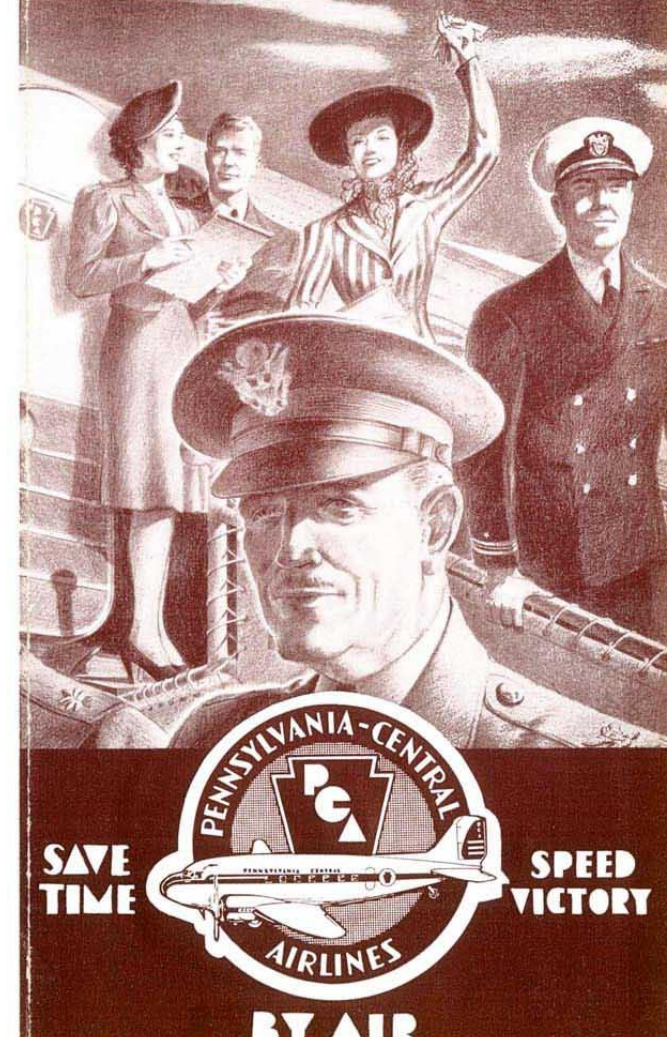
