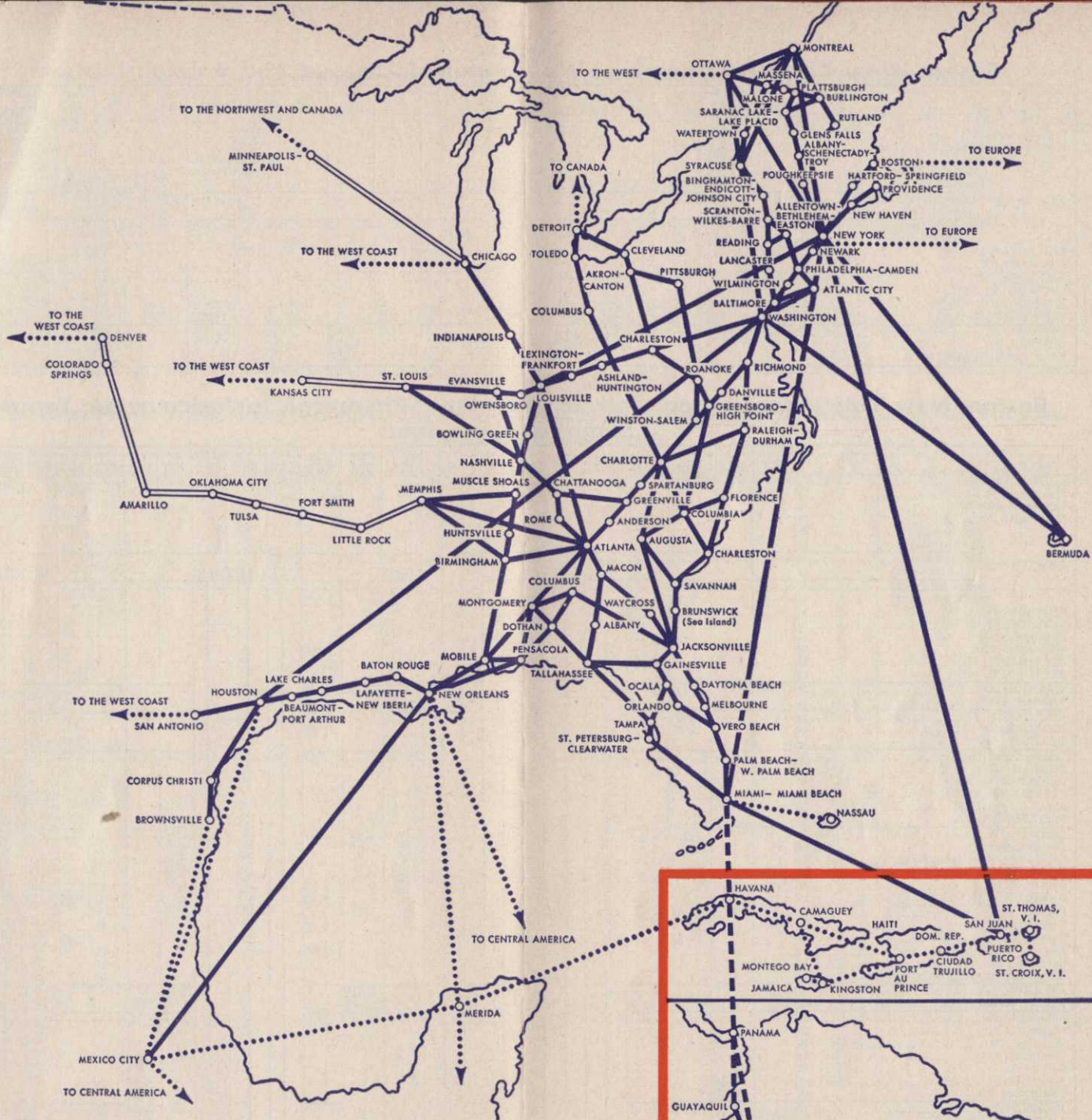





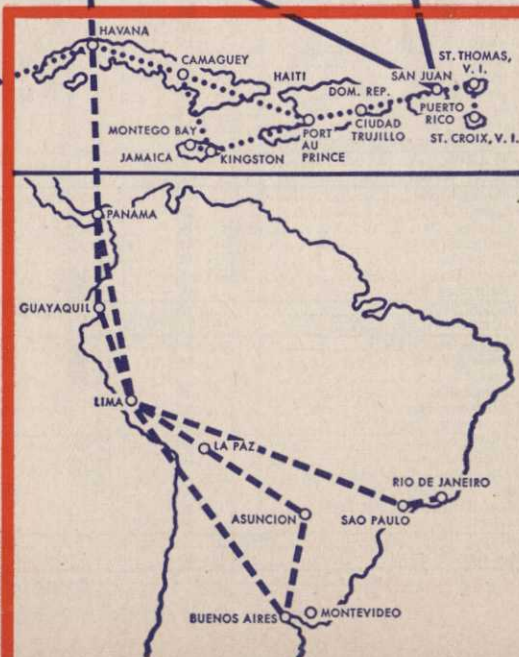

TICKETS: When your reservation has been confirmed, you will be requested to purchase your ticket by a specified time. Failure to do so at or before the designated time will result in cancellation of your reservation.

CHILDREN: One child under two not occupying a seat and accompanied by a passenger at least twelve, will be carried free. Children two and over but under twelve pay half fare when accompanied by a passenger at least twelve.

BAGGAGE (Domestic): Forty (40) pounds of baggage carried free. Baggage in excess of forty pounds including parcels, briefcases, portable typewriters and cameras, will be charged for at published excess rates.

(International): Additional baggage may be carried free on each ticket of passengers bound to or from any place outside the United States or Canada. The total free allowance (44 or 66 lbs.) is determined by the class of service that is used.

(Carry-on): Save time. Carry your baggage on and off Eastern Air Lines' Silver Falcon flights.

CANCELLATION OF PASSAGE (by the passenger): If your travel plans change and you will not be able to use your reservation, please cancel your reservation immediately so that some one else may be accommodated.

YOU MUST RECONFIRM: In ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., BERMUDA, CANADA, and all cities in the states of FLORIDA, NEW YORK, VERMONT and PENNSYLVANIA, except NEW YORK CITY, N.
