PASSENGER INFORMATION

The information herein contained is subject to change without notice, and is also subject to the tariffs, rules and regulations of the Company, whose services are shown herein, which are available at our offices. The term "Company" as used herein shall mean Pacific Alaska Airways, Inc.

SCHEDULES: Schedules of the Company are not guaranteed, and are subject to change without notice: The Company is not, nor shall be held, responsible for errors or omissions either in time tables or in any statement or representations of dates or times of departure or arrival, or for inconvenience, expense, injury, loss or damage resulting from delay or failure to make connections. The Company does not undertake to commence or complete transportation of passengers and/or baggage at or within any particular or specified time. In the event of non-completion of passage the Company shall be entitled to a pro-rata part of the fare.

FARES: Round-Trip Fares: When round-trip tickets are purchased in advance, 10% discount from twice one-way normal fares will be granted unless round-trip fares are published otherwise.

Return Trip Discount: Passengers who desire to return by air to the point of origin stated on the Identification Coupon of their one-way ticket for outward passage, will be granted 10% discount from the normal one-way fare from the outward destination on such Coupon to the point of origin thereof where outward passage originated, provided the return passage completes a round-trip.

Children's Fares: A child under two years of age, carried in the arms of its parent or guardian, will be carried without charge so long as it does not occupy a seat, the adult fare for the parent or guardian having been paid. A child two years of age or over, but under twelve years of age, may travel at one-half of the normal adult one-way, round-trip or circle-trip fare, and may occupy a seat.

STOPOVERS AND LIMITS: Stopover may be made at any scheduled stop unless published otherwise. Passage limit is one year after date of original departure. Passengers are cautioned that space for onward passage under stop-over tickets may not be available and that it is to their interest to reserve space in advance for as much of the route as possible.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE AND EXCESS CHARGES: The free weight allowance of baggage is 20 kilos (44 lbs.).

Excess baggage over the above allowance will be charged for at 1% of the normal adult one-way fare per kilo (2.2 lbs.). On stopover tickets, excess baggage charges will be collected at 1% of the normal adult fare per kilo (2.2 lbs.) for the passage between stopover points.

Children traveling on half-fare tickets will receive one-half the baggage allowance granted on full fare tickets, but their excess baggage will be charged at the full tariff rate. Children under two years of age will receive no free allowance.

BAGGAGE VALUATION CHARGES: Checked baggage (as defined in tariff regulations) declared at a value in excess of \$100.00 U. S. Cy., and unchecked baggage (as defined in said regulations) declared at a value in excess of \$100.00 U. S. Cy., will be subject to additional charges at the rate of 15¢ U. S. Cy. per each \$100.00 U. S. Cy., or fraction thereof, of such excess value. Such additional charges are payable upon declaration of value being made.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS are subject to tariff regulations on file at Company offices.

TRANSFERS: AIRPORTS—CITY CENTERS: Where local transfer services are maintained or operated by the Company at the points stated in the Tariff on file at each office, there is no additional charge for such service.

HOTEL CHARGES AND RESERVATIONS: Hotel expenses are not included in passenger fares. When requested by passengers, representatives of the Company will make application on their behalf for hotel reservations, but they do not guarantee the availability thereof. All expenses incurred by the Company or its representatives in arranging, or attempting to arrange, for reservations will be chargeable to passengers.
