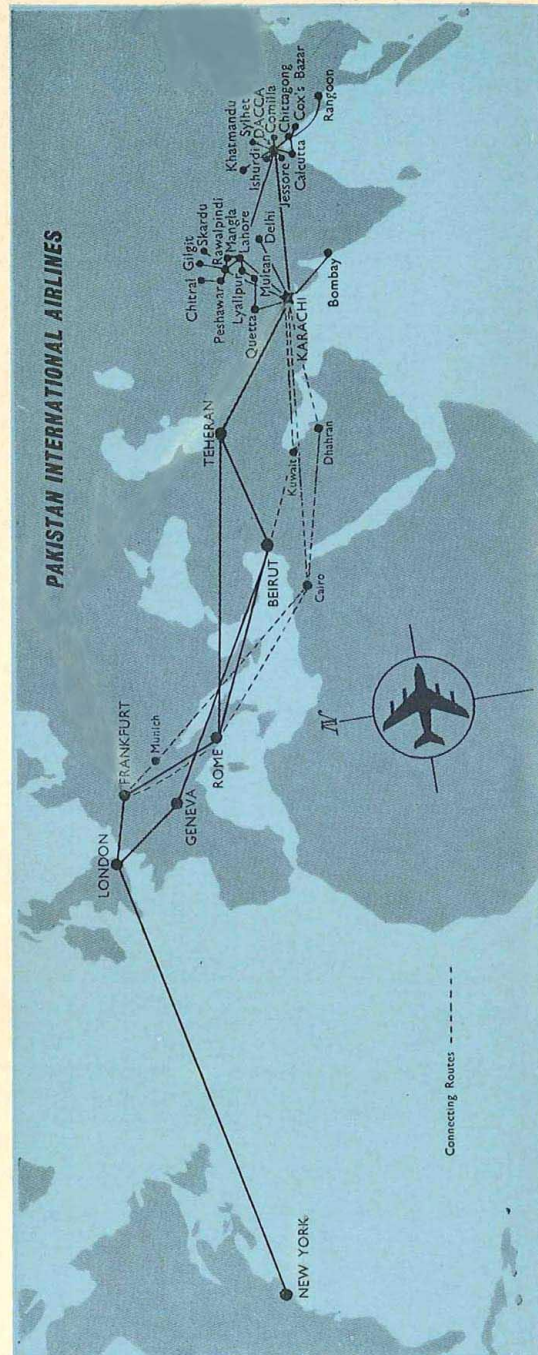

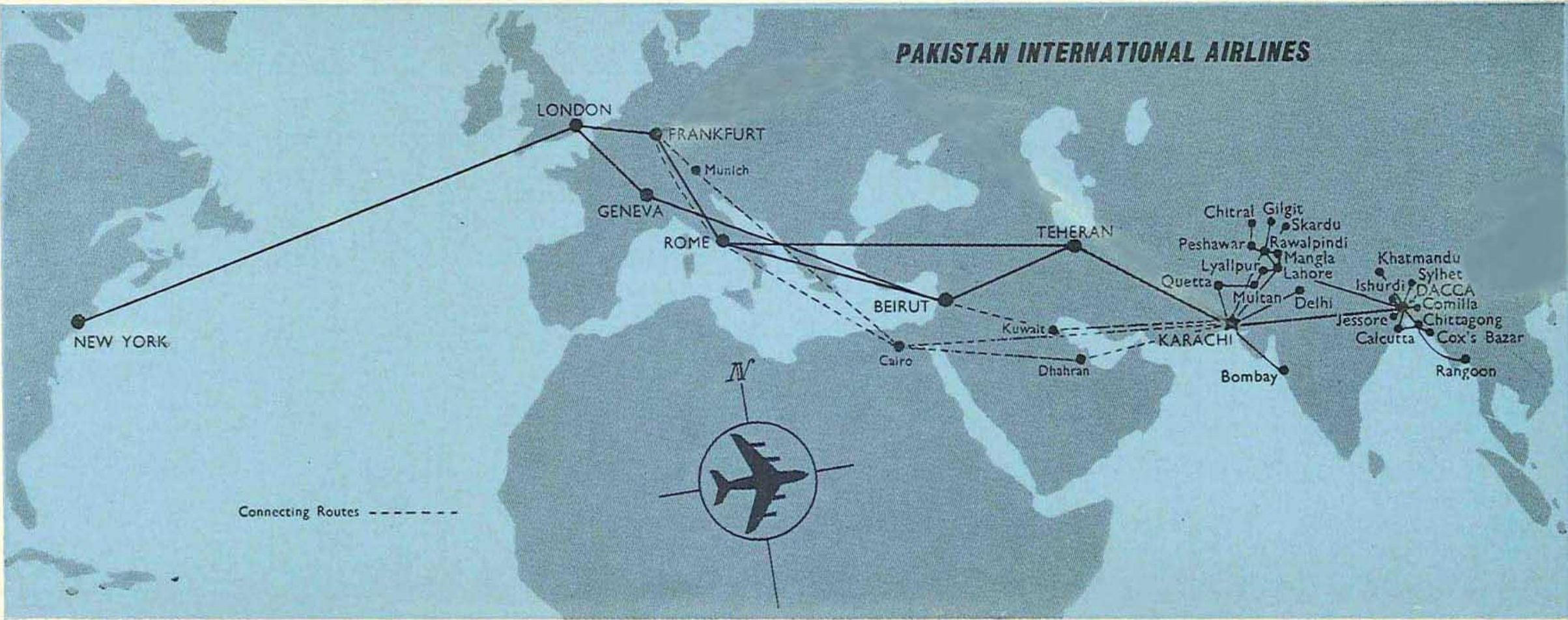

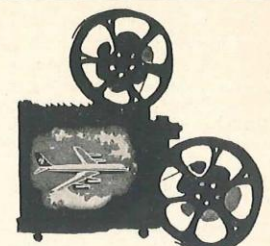

GENERAL INFORMATION

RESERVATIONS

Your reservation should be made well in advance either through a travel agent or through PIA booking office.

RECONFIRMATION

Passengers holding return or onward reservation for travel from any of the following areas, are required to reconfirm their intention to use such reservation at least 72 hours prior to the departure of their flight from such an area, provided their stay within that particular area exceeds a period of 72 hours.

- (a) Hawaii, Canada and Continental U.S.A. (excluding Alaska);
- (b) Geographical Europe including the islands adjacent thereto, United Kingdom, Ireland and the whole of Turkey;
- (c) Middle East (Asia West of Pakistan), including U.A.R., Sudan, Lybia and Tunisia;
- (d) Israel;
- (e) Africa (except Northern and Southern Rhodesia, Nyasaland and East Africa), Mauritius, Republic of Malagasy and Reunion;
- (f) Japan, Hong Kong and Philippines;
- (g) Australia, New Zealand and Fiji.

To reconfirm-contact any office of the carrier located within the area described above from which your return or continuing flight will depart.

Failure to comply will result in the cancellation of all onward and return reservations.

TAX OR CHARGES

Some Governments impose different taxes and airport service charges which the passengers are expected to pay. Before your departure please check this with your travel agency or PIA booking office.

PASSPORT, VISAS ETC.

All information regarding passport, visas and other forms you will require for the journey can be had at the PIA office.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

Various health certificates are required for entry into most countries. You will be expected to submit certificates of inoculation against cholera, vaccination against small pox and in some countries inoculation against typhoid, yellow fever etc.

CURRENCY

There are restrictions on the amount of cash currency you can take into and out of different countries. Travellers are requested to carry only a small amount in cash and the balance as travellers' cheques or letters of credit.

STOPOVERS

Except when precluded by Government order, you may break your journey at one or more places enroute, and retain the benefit of the through fare, provided notice is given at the time of reservation. Hotel expenses at each stopover will be traveller's responsibility.

CHILDREN AND INFANTS

An infant under two accompanied by an adult, and not occupying a separate seat, is charged 10% of the normal first, tourist or economy adult fare. Additional infants under two accompanying the same adult, an infant under two occupying a separate seat, and children of two years of age and over, who have not yet reached their twelfth birthday are charged 50 per cent. of the normal first, tourist or economy adult fare. Age is taken as that at the beginning of the outward journey.

STUDENTS

Special reduced fares are available for students over 12 and under 26 years of age. For details kindly apply to any authorised travel agent or PIA booking office.

BAGGAGE

(a) **Free Allowance:** On first class service the free baggage allowance is 30 kilos (66 lbs). On tourist and Economy Class service it is 20 kilos (44 lbs). Passengers travelling part-way by one class of service and part-way by another are given the free baggage allowance applicable to the class of fare paid. Free baggage allowance on night coach services is 30 lbs.

(b) **Personal Articles:** i.e. a lady's handbag or lady's pocket-book, an overcoat or wrap, a foot rug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera and/or a pair of binoculars, a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight, infant's food for consumption in flight, infant's carrying basket and a fully collapsible invalid's wheel chair and/or a pair of crutches: provided that the passenger is dependent upon them. Other reading matter, brief cases, overnight bags, attache cases, parcels, typewriters, heavy cameras, vanity or cosmetic cases, hat boxes and personal radios are weighed as part of free allowance. If this is exceeded you become liable to excess baggage charges.

(c) **Excess Charges:** Details of excess baggage—can be obtained from any PIA booking office.

(d) **Children and Infants:** Children paying half fare get the adult free baggage allowance. Infants travelling at 10 per cent. fare have no free allowance but a carry cot and infants food for consumption enroute may be carried without charge.

(e) **Domestic Pets:** On certain services domestic pets may be carried provided arrangements are made in advance.

TRANSISTORS, ETC. Passengers are not allowed to operate personal radios (transistors etc.) or other electric devices on board the aircraft.

FIRE ARMS AND AMMUNITION

Passengers carrying revolvers or any other type of arms or ammunition are required to hand-over the same to the Captain of the aircraft before emplanment for safe custody during the flight.
