#### GENERAL

#### PASSENGERS

#### Baggage - Free Allowance

On domestic services 20 kilos for adults and children of 2 years and over, with the exception of Gezira Services and Economy Class Services where the allowance is 10 kilos only.

On international services 30 kilos for adults and children of 2

No free baggage is allowed for infants under 2 years (A carrycot, bedding, infants' food for consumption en-route, etc., are carried free).

#### Baggage - Personal Allowance

In addition to the above free allowance, the following articles may be carried either in the passenger cabin or the cargo compartment:

A pair of binoculars

A lady's handbag or pocket book An overcoat or wrap

A footrug

An umbrella or walking stick

A reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight

A fully collapsible invalids' wheelchair A small pocket camera

#### Baggage - Excess Weight

Baggage weighing in excess of the free baggage allowance will be charged for at the published rate and accepted subject to space availability.

#### Baggage - Unaccompanied

Unaccompanied baggage is charged for at  $509/_{6}$  of the basic cargo rate, provided it is not less than  $10~\rm kilos.$  Full details are given on application.

#### Cancellations

Passengers who do not travel on the service for which they hold firm reservations and who have not cancelled in advance, are liable to payment of a "No-Show" charge. Refund of fare for reservations cancelled or transferred at short notice cannot be guaranteed.

#### Children

Children who have reached their second but not their twelfth birthday, travel at 50% of the published adult fare. One infant under 2 years of age accompanying an adult passenger is carried at 10% of the published fare provided it does not occupy an individual seat. A second infant under 2, and those occupying individual seats, will be charged 50%. Children below the age of 8 years will not be permitted to travel unless accompanied by an adult.

#### Departures

Passengers must attend sufficiently early either at the Town Terminal or at the Airport (by previous arrangement only) to allow embarkation formalities to be completed. Flights cannot be delayed for passengers arriving late and Sudan Airways cannot accept responsibility in such cases.

#### Health Certificates

Certain countries require valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination. Passengers are, therefore, advised to enquire well in advance whether any such certificates are required.

#### Punctuality

While every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of the services, Sudan Airways cannot accept responsibility for the delay or suspension of a service, nor guarantee that connections will be made with other air services or surface carriers.

#### Stopovers

A passenger may break his journey at one or more intermediate points for as long as desired within the validity of the ticket provided that Sudan Airways are informed in advance. All hotel expenses are payable by passengers during stop-overs arranged at their request.

#### Student Fares

Rebated fares are available for schoolchildren and students who have reached their twelfth but not their twenty-sixth birthday on international services only. Details are provided on request.

#### Ticket Validity

The validity of single and return tickets is one year from the date of starting the first flight or, if unused, from date of issue.

#### CARGO

#### Quantity Discount

A discount of  $25\%_0$  of the basic air cargo rate applies to all consignments of 45 kilos or over. The quantity discount is not added to any other type of rebate and does not apply to valuable cargo.

#### Commodity and Classification Rates

Special rates are available for certain commodities and types of cargo. Full details are given on application.

#### Valuable Cargo

Gold and Platinum (unmanufactured and semi-manufactured), Precious Stones, Legal Banknotes, Specie (including coins), Securities, Shares and Share Coupons and Watches are charged for at 150% of the basic cargo rate ( no quantity discount ).

#### PROHIBITED ARTICLES

Articles such as the following shall not be carried as air cargo or in the passengers' baggage without prior consent of and arrangement with Sudan Airways.

Compressed gases (flammable, non-flammable and poisonous);

Corrosives ( such as acids, wet batteries );

Explosives, munitions, fireworks and articles which are easily ignited; Flammable liquids and solids ( such as matches, lighter fuels,

rubbing alcohol ); Oxidising materials;

Poisons:


Radioactive materials;
