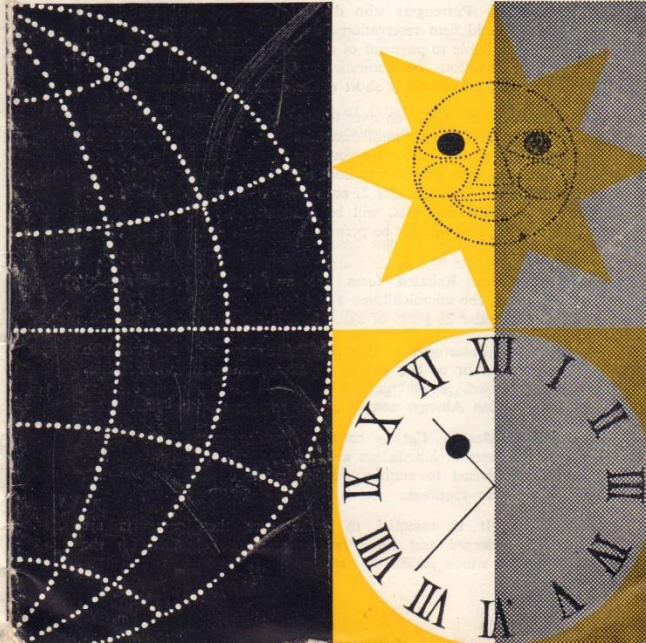

GENERAL INFORMATION

PASSENGERS

Baggage—Free Allowance. *On domestic services:* 20 kilos for adults and children of 2 years and over, with the exception of Gezira Services and Economy Class Services where the allowance is 10 kilos only. *On international services:* 30 kilos for adults and children of 2 years and over travelling first class—and the same on "B" class services; 20 kilos for adults and children of 2 years and over travelling tourist class. No free baggage is allowed for infants under 2 years. (A carrycot, bedding, a reasonable amount of infants' food for consumption en route, etc., are counted as part of the infant's own weight.)

Baggage—Personal Allowance. In addition to the above free allowance, the following articles may be carried either in the passenger cabin or the cargo compartment:

<i>A pair of binoculars</i>	<i>A lady's handbag or pocket book</i>
<i>A footrug</i>	<i>An overcoat or wrap</i>
<i>An umbrella or walking stick</i>	<i>A reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight</i>
<i>A fully collapsible invalid's wheelchair</i>	<i>A small pocket camera</i>

Brief cases, typewriters and other parcels are, however, weighed as part of the free allowance.

Baggage—Excess Weight. Baggage weighing in excess of the free baggage allowance will be charged for at the appropriate rate and accepted only if space is available on the aircraft.

Baggage—Unaccompanied. Unaccompanied baggage may be sent at a special rate which is 50% of the basic cargo rate, provided it weighs not less than 10 kilos. Unaccompanied baggage may contain personal effects and clothing but *not* such items as furs, jewellery, liquor, perfumes etc.

Cancellations. Passengers who do not travel on the service for which they hold firm reservations, and who have not cancelled in advance, are liable to payment of a cancellation fee. Refund of full fare for reservations on domestic services which are cancelled or transferred at unreasonably short notice cannot be guaranteed.

Children's Fares. Children over the age of 2 and under the age of 12 travel at 50% of the published adult fare. One infant under 2 years of age accompanying an adult passenger is carried at 10% of the published fare provided it does not occupy an individual seat. Any additional infants under 2, accompanied by only one adult and occupying individual seats, will be charged 50%. Children below the age of 8 years will not be permitted to travel unless accompanied by an adult.

Student Fares. Rebated fares are available, on international services only, for schoolchildren and students who are over 12 years of age but under 26 years of age. Details are provided on request.

Departures. Passengers must arrive sufficiently early either at the town terminal or at the airport to allow embarkation formalities to be completed. Flights cannot be delayed for passengers arriving late and Sudan Airways cannot accept responsibility in such cases.

Health Certificates. Certain countries require travellers to possess valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination. Passengers are, therefore, advised to enquire well in advance whether any such certificates are required.

Passports. It is essential to make sure that passports are correctly endorsed and the necessary visas are obtained for the countries to which passengers are going.

Currency. Banks and travel agencies have details of prevailing currency restrictions in the countries to which passengers are going and it is advisable to find these out in advance.

Punctuality. While every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of all services, Sudan Airways cannot accept responsibility for the delay or suspension of a service, nor guarantee that connections will be made with other air services or surface carriers.

Stopovers. A passenger may break his journey at one or more intermediate points for as long as desired within the validity of the ticket provided that Sudan Airways are informed in advance. All ground transport and hotel expenses during stopovers arranged at passengers' request are their own responsibility.

Tickets. Tickets are issued subject to the Airline's Conditions of Carriage, details of which can be given on request.

The validity of single and return tickets is one year from the date of starting the first flight or, if unused, from date of issue.

Your fare includes meals and light refreshments in flight, and ground transport between airports and town terminals except at London, Rome and Cairo. At London, Rome and Khartoum there are also airport service charges for embarking passengers of 7s. 6d., 700 lire and 25 pt. respectively.

CARGO

Quantity Discount. A discount of 25% of the basic air cargo rate applies to all consignments of 45 kilos or over. The quantity discount is not added to any other type of rebate and does not apply to valuable cargo.

Commodity and Classification Rates. Special rates are available for certain commodities and types of cargo. Full details are given on application.

Valuable Cargo. Gold and Platinum (unmanufactured and semi-manufactured), legal banknotes, securities, shares and share coupons are charged for at 150% of the basic cargo rate (no quantity discount).

Prohibited Articles.

Articles such as the following shall not be carried as air cargo or in passengers' baggage without prior consent of and arrangement with Sudan Airways:

*Compressed gases (flammable, non-flammable and poisonous);
Corrosives (such as acids, wet batteries);
Explosives, munitions, fireworks and articles which are easily ignited;
Flammable liquids and solids (such as matches, lighter fuels, rubbing alcohol);
Oxidising materials;
Poisons;
Radioactive materials;
Other restricted articles (such as mercury, magnetic material, offensive or irritating materials).*

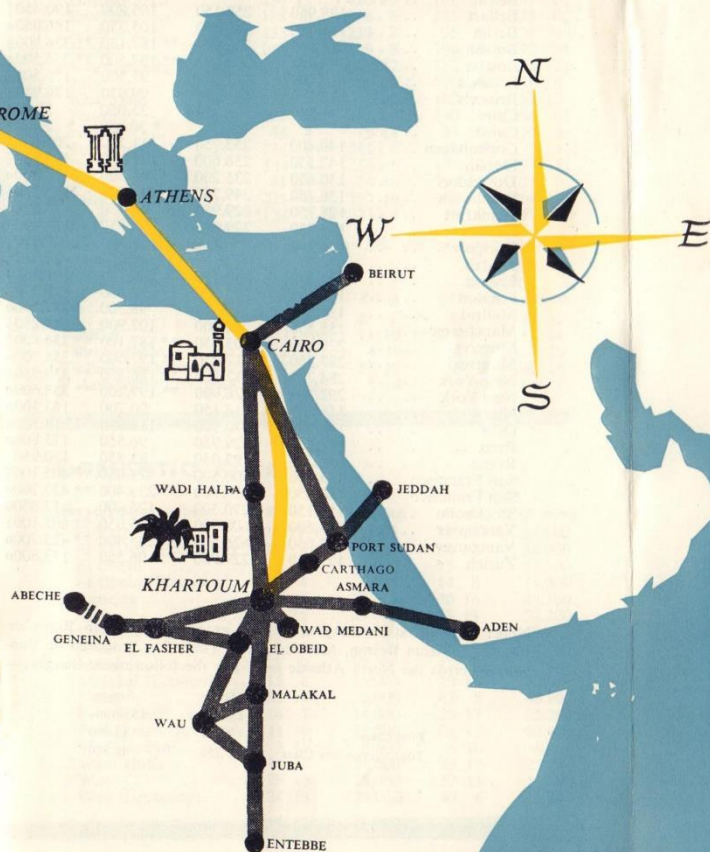
SUDAN AIRWAYS

As well as services in the Sudan and to neighbouring countries Sudan Airways now runs a weekly service between London and Khartoum, via Rome, Athens, and Cairo. The aircraft is a Vickers Viscount 831, maintained and crewed by the British airline, Airwork, and the service is called the BLUE NILE Viscount. This route and the others which make up the Sudan Airways network are shown on the map below.

LONDON TO KHARTOUM

Every Monday, a BLUE NILE Viscount leaves Gatwick Airport for Khartoum via the Fabled Cities of Rome, Athens, and Cairo. Passengers wishing to break their journey at one of these cities may do so and continue by a later aircraft at no extra cost. The northbound journey from Khartoum is made every Thursday.

In 1945 Rolls Royce engines powered the first propeller-turbine engined aircraft in the world—the Meteor. The Dart is a refinement of that first prop-jet engine. Ten years later, the VISCOUNT 800 took the air equipped with DART engines of up to 2,500 e.h.p., capable of 400 m.p.h., and with a seating capacity of up to 72. The 831 is part of the latest 810-840 series, and Vickers VISCOUNTS today are in service in more countries of the world than any other airliner in aviation history since the Dakota.
