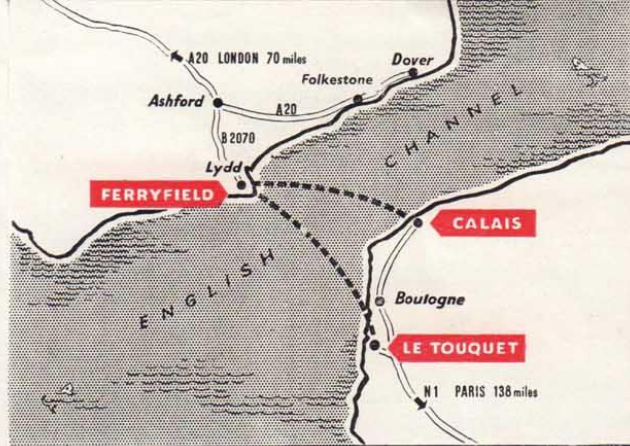
Air Ferry fares may be paid in sterling and are not deducted from your travel allowance. All vehicle fares provide for carriage at carrier's risk.
